Fentanyl Information with William Solari

Fentanyl is a powerful and addictive synthetic opioid. It is cheap to produce. A small amount of Fentanyl can be fatal (drug poisoning). Statistics were shared. Fake Adderall, Percocet and Xanax often contain Fentanyl. You should never take a prescription pill from anyplace other than a doctor or pharmacist. Frisco ISD has warning posters in all secondary schools. Red Ribbon Week has lessons related to the dangers of using drugs. FISD also has specific lessons for middle and high school students on the dangers of Fentanyl. We also hosted a Town Hall event in collaboration with the City of Frisco and the Frisco PD. All campuses have Narcan in their clinics. Texas Education Code 38.040. requires schools to find a researched based curriculum on the dangers of opioids, addiction and abuse of opioids.
