SENDING YOUR SAT & ACT TEST SCORES TO COLLEGES

SAT scores should be sent to:

- 1 UC if you send to 1 UC, all UCs receive it
- Cal State Apply (in Long Beach) # 3594 by sending here, all CSUs receive it
- ALL private and out of state schools to which you are applying
- NCAA (#9999) if planning to participate in college sports

A Few More Details

- With every SAT registration, you can send a score report to 4 colleges for free (they can be used/sent up to 9 days <u>after</u> the test day, then they <u>expire</u>). If you used a fee waiver, then you get an additional 4 <u>free</u> score reports to use/send these <u>don't expire</u> until graduation day). Each additional score report you send (beyond the free ones or sent after your "free window period") will cost you \$11 per school.
- If you and your family can't afford to send score reports to all the colleges you are applying to, please talk to Mr. Weintraub about having Lighthouse help you cover some of these fees.
- If you took the December SAT, you should wait to send those scores until these come out but don't forget!!! If you already have other available scores, you should send those now!

To send your scores or to confirm that you have included all the schools, log into your SAT account:

- Click on "Send Scores." Next to My Scores, click on "see sent scores" to see which schools have received
 which test scores. If necessary, return to My SAT page and click on "send available scores now" and add
 schools that still needed to receive it.
- If you are taking the SAT in December: Click on "Send Scores," and then click on "send scores when available" (needs to be done no later than 9 days after your last testing date)

ACT scores should be sent to:

- 1 UC if you send to 1 UC, all UCs receive
- ALL CSUs separately
- ALL privates and out of state schools
- NCAA (#9999) if planning to participate in college sports

ACT score reports only show one test (you chose when sending).

ALL the schools you will apply to need to receive ALL your scores from ALL ACT tests.

- With every ACT registration, you can send a score report to 4 colleges for free. If you used a fee waiver, then you get an additional 4 <u>free</u> score reports to use/send (ALL free score reports expire at 10 a.m. on the Thursday AFTER your test day). Each additional score report you send (beyond the free ones or sent after your "free window period") will cost you \$11 per school.
- Log into http://www.actstudent.org/ to send your scores to CSUs, UCs, and/or ther colleges. Make sure the score reports you send include the writing section).
- If you and your family can't afford to send score reports to all the colleges you are applying to, please talk to Mr. Weintraub about having Lighthouse help you cover some of these fees.

If you have listed a CSU campus as an ACT score report recipient, you can use the ACT Score Manager (found on the www.csumentor.edu site to release your score(s) to all the CSU campuses you applied to. Before you can use the ACT Score Manager, you must first have arranged for your scores to be sent to a CSU campus. You will release your score from ACT Score Manager on College App Day (AFTER) you submit all your CSU applications.
