

Rules

You can submit up to 10 of your most wanted figures. It's best to be specific as necessary, but not overly specific. To tabulate the results, we go through a process of "cleaning" the submissions. This means that the submitted names, which are free form, get aggregated into standard names. For example, if one user submits "Princess Leia Ewok Village" and another user submits "Princess Leia Ewok Dress", we will standardize both of those entries to "Princess Leia (Ewok Dress - Episode VI)" so that that can be summed appropriately. It is critical that you understand this "cleaning" process as it can cause you to lose a vote, **as we only allow you to vote for a character once**. We don't want "ballot stuffing" for Last Figures Standing as it can distort overall demand. We're not trying to judge passion, which doesn't necessarily translate to sales. Ten fans *really* wanting a certain figure shouldn't outweigh twenty fans who would buy a different figure. In our opinion, passionate and highly vocal minorities have paved the path to some of the biggest peg warmers in the line's history. We aim to ascertain raw popularity. If a user submits "Darth Maul (Episode I)" ten times, we will only count that as **one vote** for Darth Maul (Episode I).

Again, it's critical that you understand this cleaning process so that you don't lose votes, as, except for the various Clone Units, **we standardize to the sculpt and not the card, paint applications, or accessories**. An example of this from past years came from Anakin Skywalker in his Episode III appearance. Some fans were asking for that figure from the World Between Worlds scene in the *Ahsoka* series. Other fans were asking for that figure from *Revenge of the Sith*. Since those would be the same exact sculpt, they would both get cleaned to Anakin Skywalker (Episode III). Therefore, if they same user submitted both "Anakin Skywalker - Revenge of the Sith" and "Anakin Skywalker - World Between Worlds", they would both become standardized to "Anakin Skywalker (Episode III)" and thus only count as one vote for that figure. Thankfully this sculpt has been made, so we don't have to worry about this specific scenario for 2025, but there are others you need to be aware of. Specifically, the following two special circumstances:

- All votes for Qi'Ra, regardless of outfit, will be standardized as Qi'Ra (Solo)
- All votes for Luthen Rael, regardless of outfit, will be standardized as Lauthen Rael (Andor)
- All votes for Clone Commandos, regardless of source, will be standardized as Republic Clone Commando

These two characters split votes due to their various appearances, but neither one has appeared in the Vintage Collection to date. We feel it's important to get them into the line first, if that's what the fans want, and then worry about subsequent appearances later. So **DO NOT** submit multiple entries for those characters in various outfits. They will ultimately only get counted as one vote if you do, but by eliminating the "vote splitting" factor, it should result in those characters placing higher on the overall list.

Finally, consult the [dashboard for the 2024 Last Figure Standing](#). This shows all the standardized names we used. If you are unsure how to phrase your entry, look to those lists, and use the standardized name. It ensures the best chance of your vote being counted accurately.
