Grocery Cards

For Shaws, Hannafords, or the Middlebury Co-op. \$50 increments seem to work best. *(Always in critical short supply.)* While most of our neighbors utilize local food shelves, data show that grocery cards—encouraging caregivers to shop and choose nourishment for their families—do a much better job instilling a sense of dignity and equity.

Gas Cards

From McIntyre Sunoco on Exchange Street in Middlebury. \$30-\$50 increments. *(Always in critical short supply.)*

Junebug Gift Cards

Gift cards to Junebug in Middlebury are an excellent way to support caregiver shopping for their children's/grandchildren's clothing and footwear needs. *(Always in critical short supply.)*

Walmart Cards

Judgment about big box stores aside, caregivers often rely on a stop at Walmart to get what they need for food, hygiene items, camping equipment, etc.
