## WHANAU UPDATE

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Next week we are asking that all students return back to school unless you are isolating with covid or a household contact.

Since the Omicron outbreak started:

We have had 15 students in the whole school who have tested positive for covid. 11 have either returned or finished their isolation.

We have had 5 staff members who have tested positive for covid. 4 have now returned to school from isolation.

We also have a number of staff and students who are Household Contacts and they must be isolated for 7 days.

Please be vigilant around symptoms and keep your child at home if they are unwell.

Student attendance has been picking up from only 25% last week to 60% this week. Next week with our seniors back this number will increase.

Changes to the COVID-19 Protection Framework for education.

- Vaccine Mandate Order for staff and Volunteers in school will be removed at 11.59pm on Monday 4 April.
- No changes to mask requirements in Red or Orange.
- Indoor capacity limits for extra-curricular activities increase from 100 to 200 people (one meter apart).
- My Vaccine Pass requirements will be removed from the framework at 11.59pm on Monday 4 April.
