Shon C

Shon: Dad, are you well?

Siegfried: That's supposed to be my question to you, son.

But yes, I am well.

Thank you.

Shon: I'm good too.

I'm feeling a lot more used to the tides of battle now.

Fighting in Atheya, where Magnian forces were weaker, helped build me up to the point where I am now...

Siegfried: Ah, yes.

Everyone starts from somewhere.

Then we climb the ranks to become stronger and face more powerful foes.

That is the life of a fighter...

But don't let it take you over.

Shon: Huh?

Siegfried: I just mean that you shouldn't let fighting become who you are.

Shon: Well, of course not!

I wouldn't want to become like Kelik, after all...

Siegfried: Hahahaha, that would indeed be unfortunate.

Very likely to happen given when you can start seeing support conversations actually)

Siegfried: Shon...

Shon: Yes?

Siegfried: How are you feeling?

you as much as he could.

C: Oh?
What did he do for me?
I'd like to hear this,
Siegfried...

S: I wasn't supposed to tell you,
but you're almost 18 years old...
When I first came, you were
already playing swords with sticks.
The mayor, Borun, saw your potential
and wanted you to become something...
Something more than just a typical
civilian, or a typical farmer.
So he agreed to let me
stay near the village,
and be apart of the community,
so long as I taught you how to fight.
And on this agreement,
we both gained a little.

C: He... what?

(Tekun's portrait is displayed instead of Haas. I've witness another instance of this happening myself in-game, so it's safe to say that you would also see Tekun instead of Haas in-game too)

Haas C

Haas: Commander Siegfried,
you're quite impressive.

Siegfried: Hm?
What is this?

H: I've been watching you fight...
You use a very refined technique.
Though it looks like it strains
you quite a bit. Is this true?

a little more unique than that...

to converse about such things.
Let us get back to the fray,
before we fall behind.

Haas A

H: Siegfried... if it's alright,
I would like to hear it.

S: The tale of my way of
the sword, you mean?

use spears, as I recall.
Do they use different
techniques?
