The search filters look like they would help in finding a product but there doesn’t appear to be a clear place to type a specific product to search which may make it difficult for someone who already knows the exact product they want.	Yes	- Added a searchbar that pops down in aisle view to search within aisle - Added text inside pop-down searchbar to clarify where you are searching - Made “Search Aisle” and “Search Storewide” buttons different colors to emphasize difference between them
When grocery shopping it’s common that someone will want to compare prices before adding something to their cart. It would be helpful to have some form of bookmark feature to save a product for comparison without having to remember what it was or add it to the cart.	No	

Similar to the last point, a “confirm add to cart” option would limit user errors with accidental purchases.	Yes	- Added a pop-up modal which asks user to select a quantity and explicitly add those items to the cart
Labels for products are not clear and require the user to look at a product’s label instead of a standard text across products.	No	
It seems like the grouping at check out is a bit over the top or unneeded which would take away from minimalism. I don’t think it hurts anything but doesn’t help much either.
