HOW TO CONNECT YOUR PERSONAL DEVICE

How do I connect my iOS device to the FUHSD WiFi?

Step 1: Under Settings>wifi, choose “fuhsd”

Step 2: Enter username and Password and click Join

Your username is your FUHSD id

Staff = firstname_lastname

Students = first name initial + last name + last 3 digits of student ID (ex. zchen467)

Your password is the same as the one you use to login to school computers

Step 3: Trust the certificate DO-ISE-ADM-1.fuhsd

***If the connection fails, “forget” the network and try again.** If it still does not connect, try adding a new network as “fuhsd” and configuring everything manually from scratch.



How do I connect my Apple laptop to the FUHSD WiFi?

Step 1: Click the wifi icon  at the top bar, choose “fuhsd”

Step 2: Input the following:

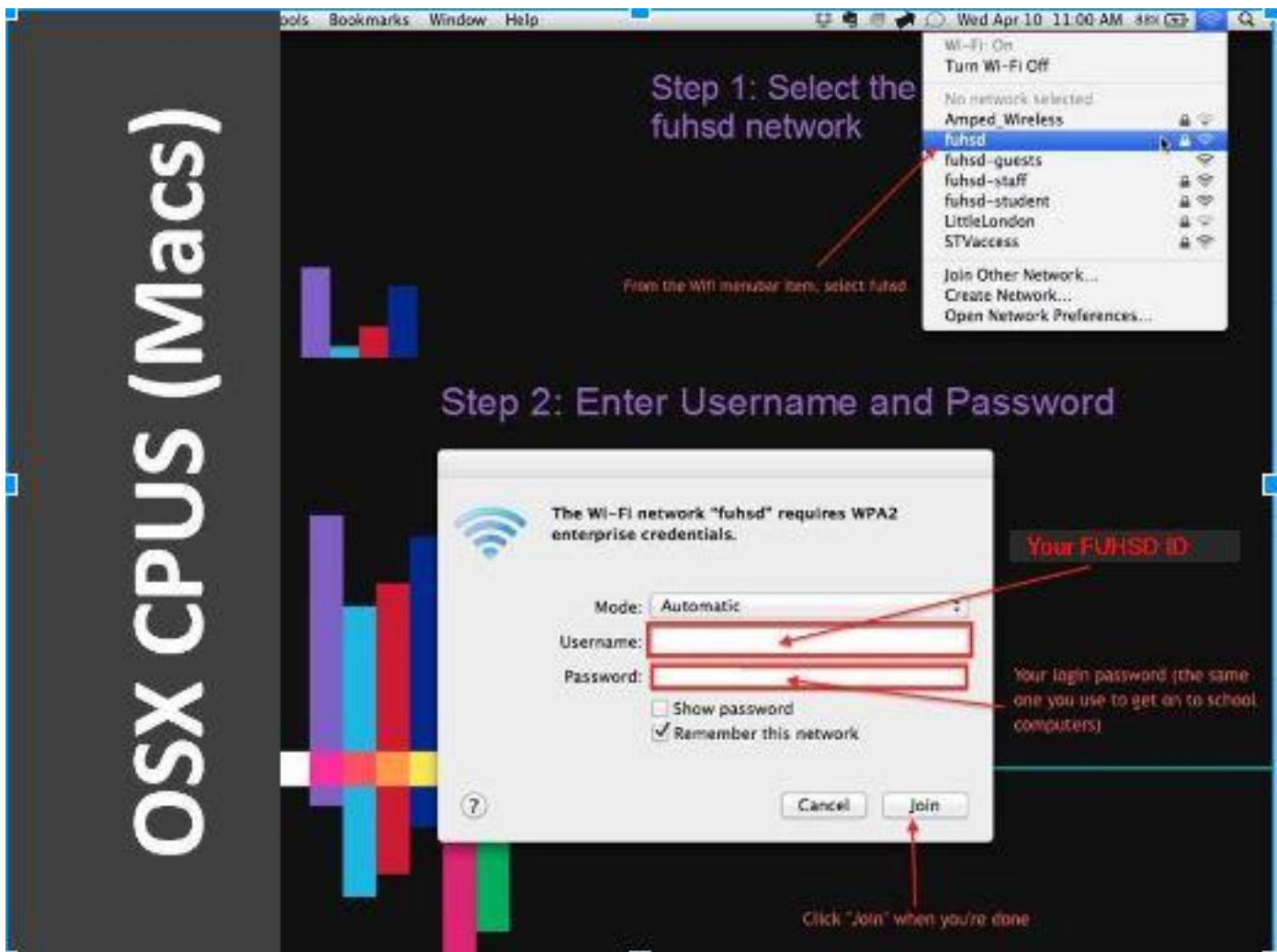
Mode: Automatic

Username: FUHSD id (see above iOS device instructions for details on what this looks like)

Password: the same password you use to log in at school

Ensure Remember Network is checked

Click Join



How do I connect my Android device to the FUHSD WiFi?

Connect using Android devices

Under Settings>Wifi, choose "fuhds" and input this configuration:

Network SSID: fuhds

Security: 802.1x EAP (or WPA2-Enterprise or WPA2-EAP)

EAP Method: PEAP

Phase 2 Authentication: MSCHAPV2

CA Certificate: (unspecified) None

User certificate: (unspecified) Do not validate

Identity:

STAFF-- SITE\firstname_lastname

STUDENTS-- SITE\first initial+last name+last 3 digits of student ID

Anonymous identity: (leave blank)

Password: user_password

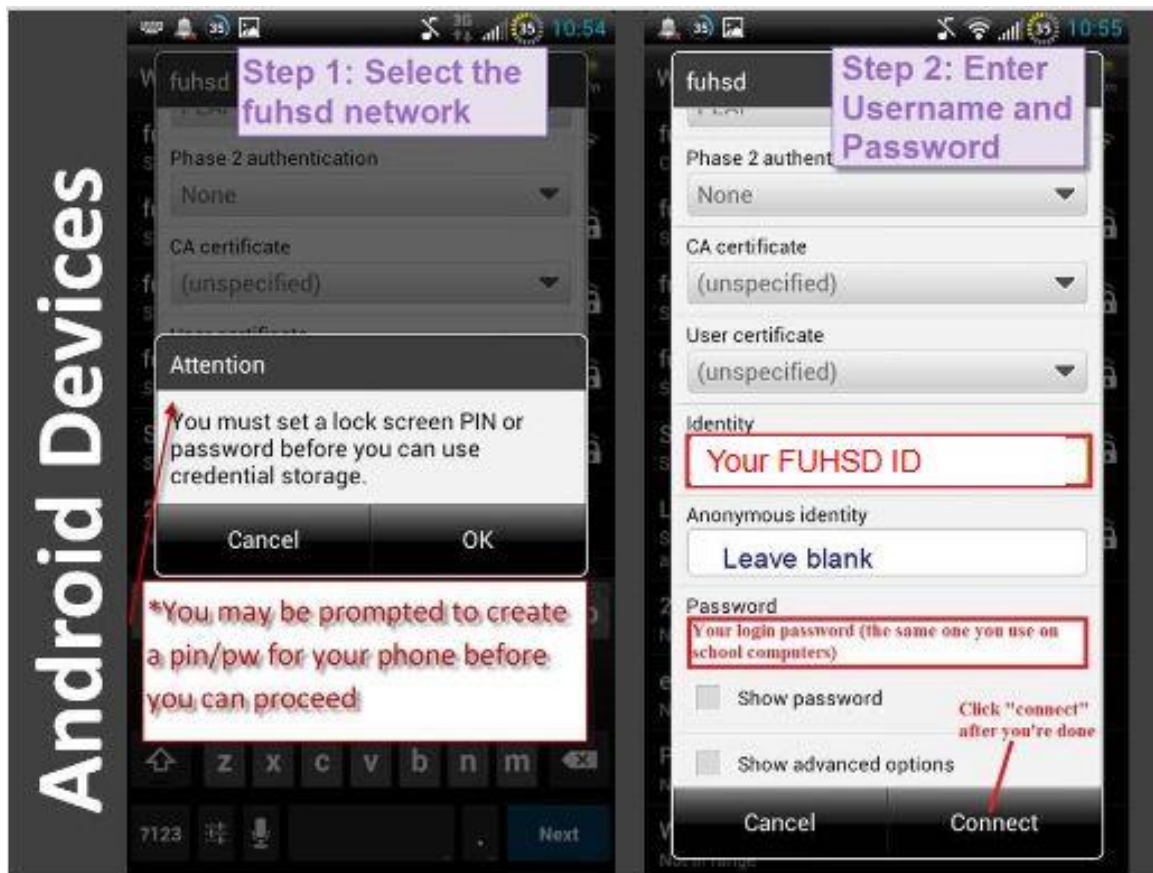
Advanced settings:

Proxy settings: None

IP settings: DHCP

*If “fuhSD” is broadcasting, but the connection fails, “forget” the network and try again. If it still does not connect, try adding a new network as “fuhSD” and configuring everything manually from scratch.

*There have been some instances on Android devices where wifi will not connect until the data plan is turned off. After the wifi connects, the data plan can be re-enabled.



How do I connect my Chromebook device to the FUHSD WiFi?

Open WiFi icon from the lower right corner of your Chromebook screen, choose "fuhsd" and input this configuration:

Network SSID: fuhsd

Security: 802.1x EAP (or WPA2-Enterprise or WPA2-EAP)

EAP Method: PEAP

Phase 2 Authentication: MSCHAPV2

Server CA Certificate:

User certificate: (unspecified) Do not check

Identity:

STAFF-- firstname_lastname

STUDENTS-- first initial+last name+last 3 digits of student ID

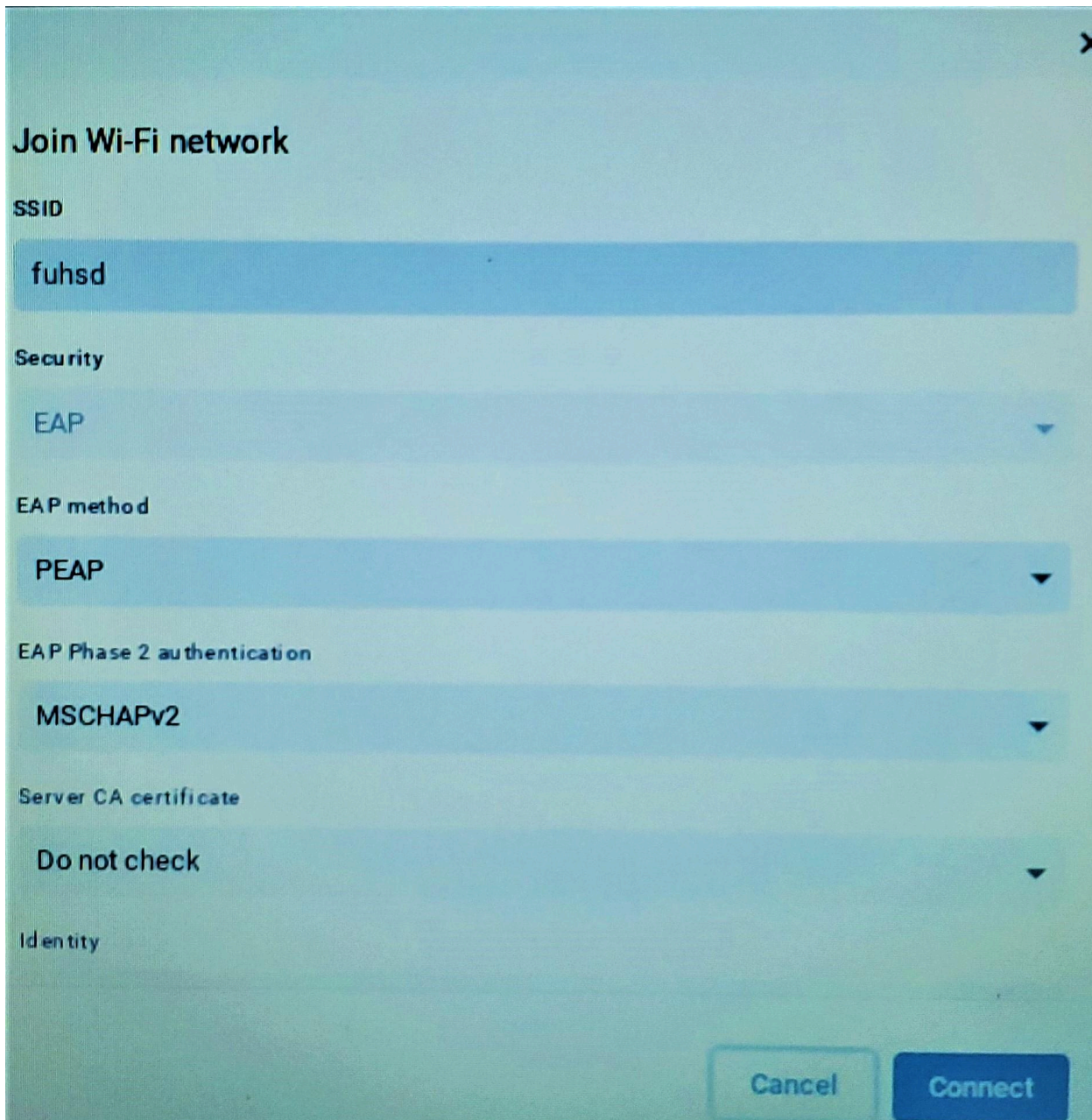
Password: user_password

Anonymous identity: (leave blank)

Save identity and password: ON

Click CONNECT Button to Proceed.

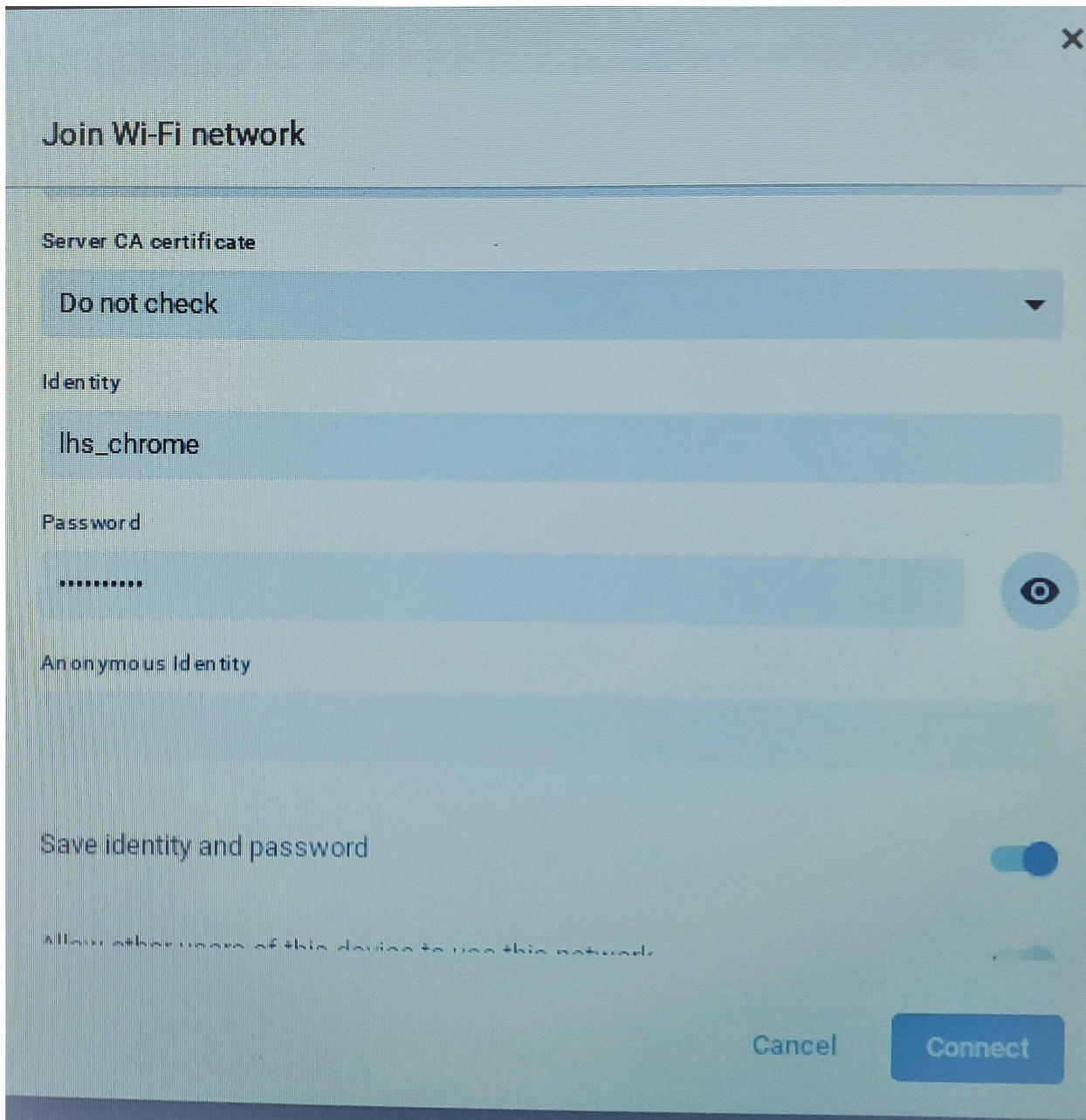

How do I connect my Windows laptop to the FUHSD WiFi?

WINDOWS 10

- Click the Wi-Fi icon in the lower right corner (near the clock)
- Select the “fuhsd” network
- You will be asked to log into the network. Use the following info:
- **Username:** School Site\ followed by your FUHSD username

- Cupertino: **CHS**\username
- Fremont: **FHS**\username
- Homestead: **HHS**\username
- Lynbrook: **LYNBROOK**\username
- Monta Vista: **MVHS**\username

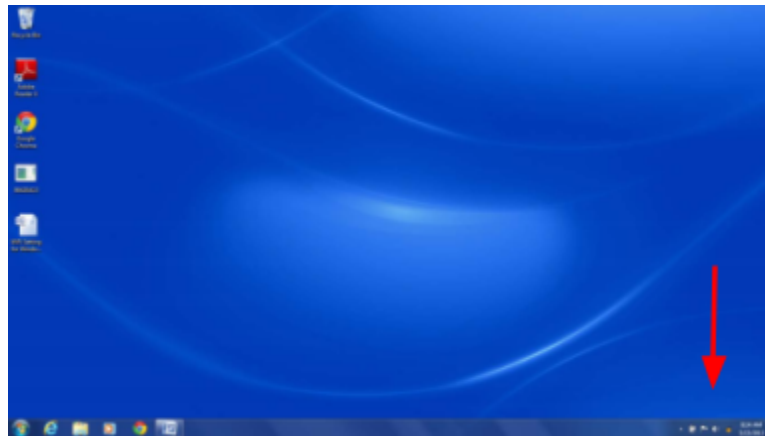
(the first part of your email address, *without* "@fuhsd.org")

- **STAFF****: *SITE*\firstname_lastname
- **STUDENTS**: *SITE*\first initial+last name+last 3 digits of student ID
- *Please note the SITE followed by a backslash \ before your Username*
- **Password**: Your FUHSD password
- Check the "Automatically Connect" box
- Click "Connect"

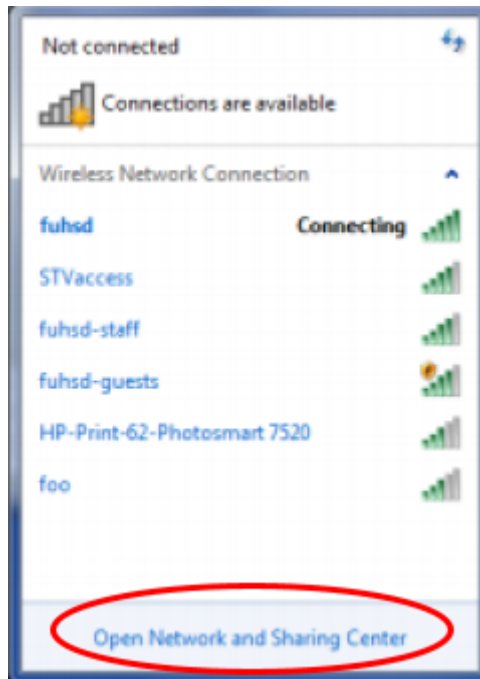
You may have to do this a few times before it connects. Restart your computer if you haven't, and try again.

For Windows 7 and prior

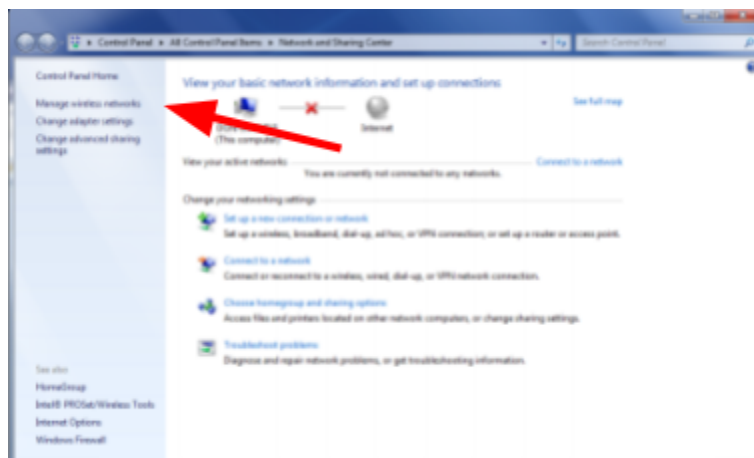
Click the wifi icon
in the system tray on the
right side of the taskbar



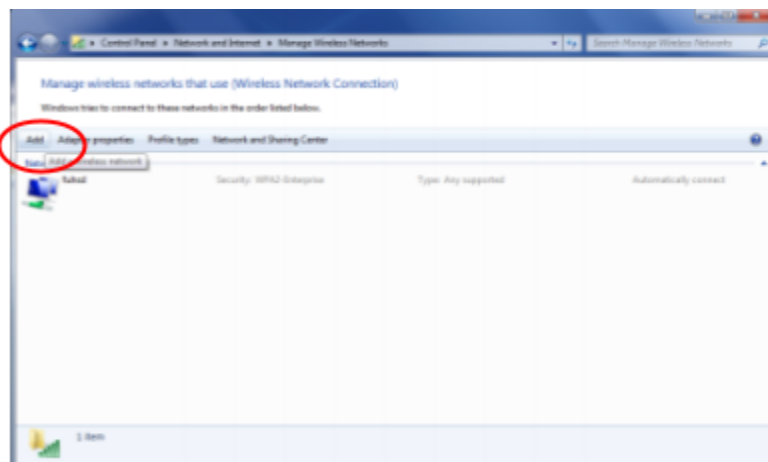
Click **Open Network and Sharing Center**



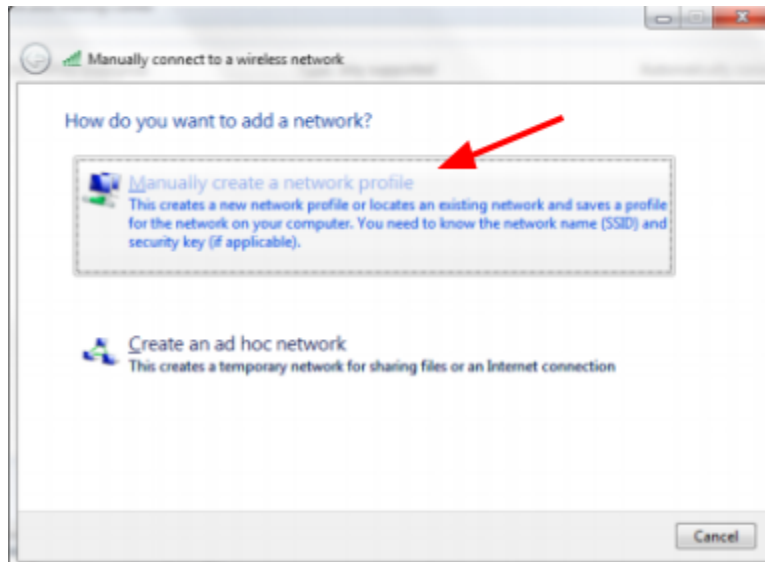
Click **Manage wireless networks** in the left-side menu



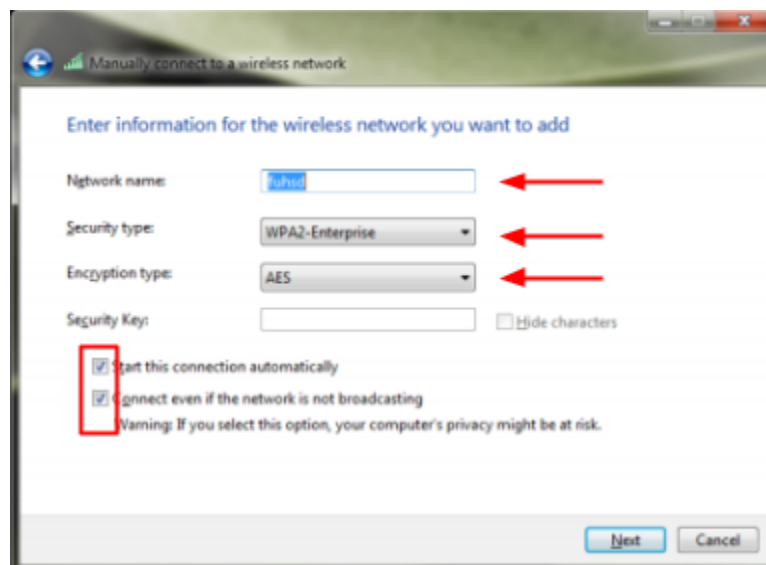
Click **Add** in the top menu



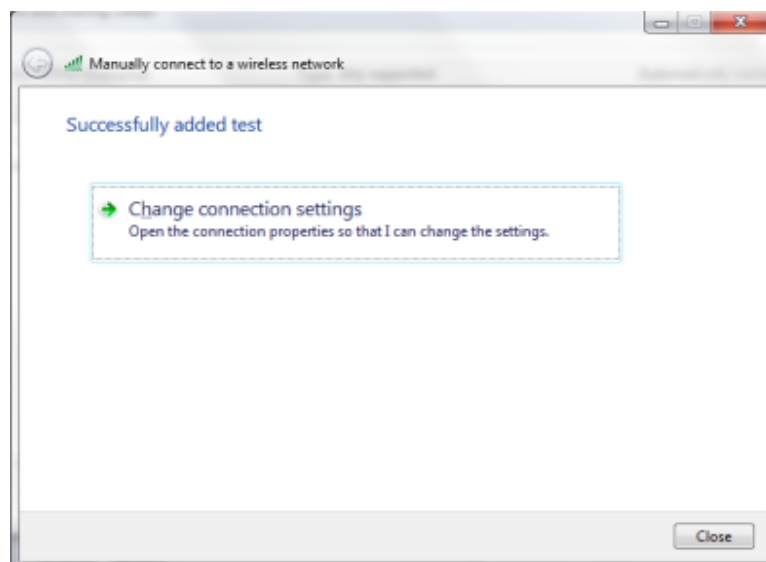
Click **Manually create a network profile**



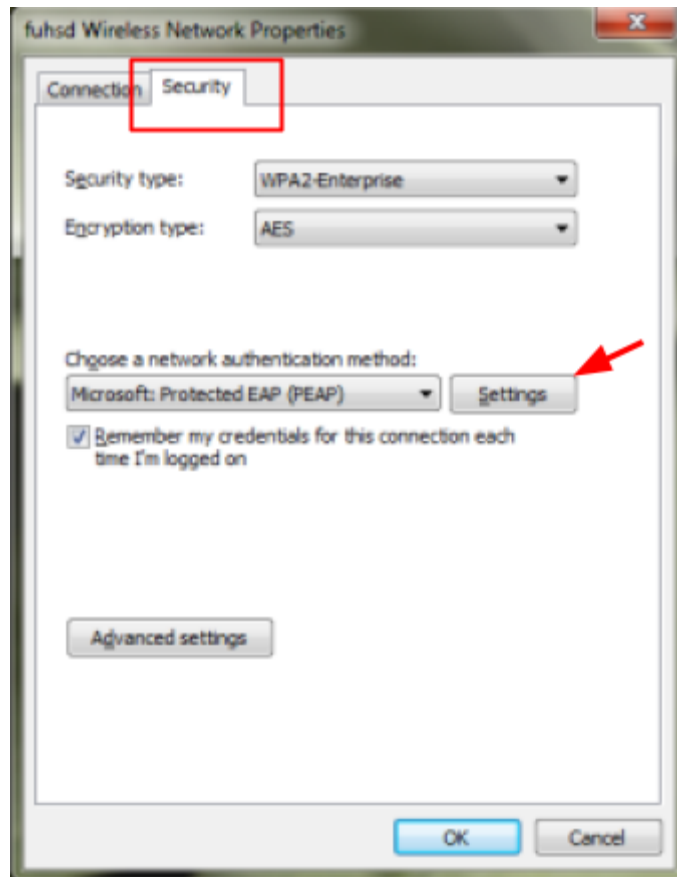
Name "fuhisd", select **WPA2-Enterprise**, check both boxes and click next



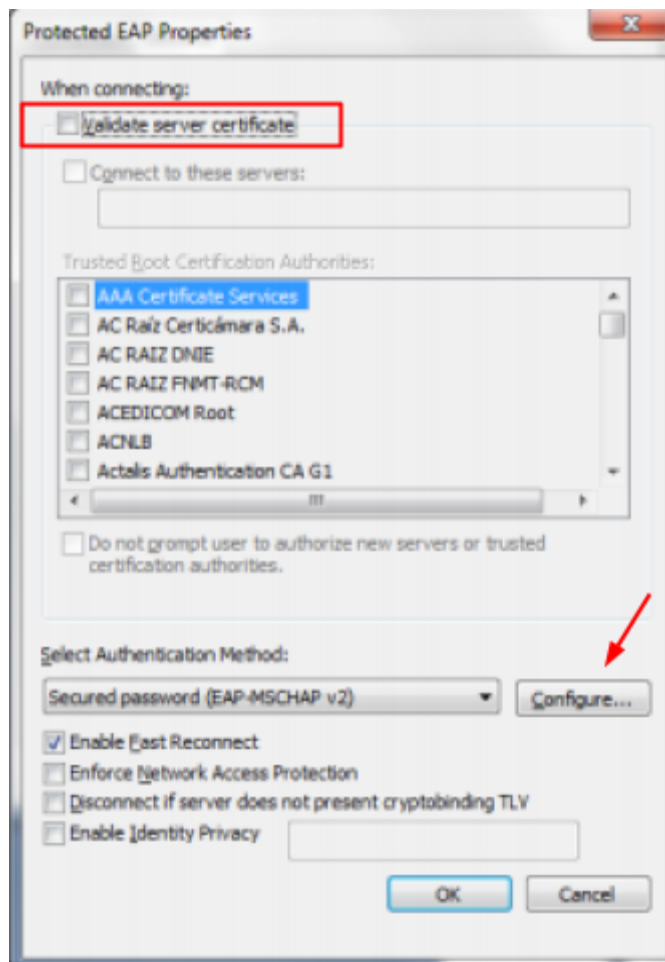
Select **Change connection settings**



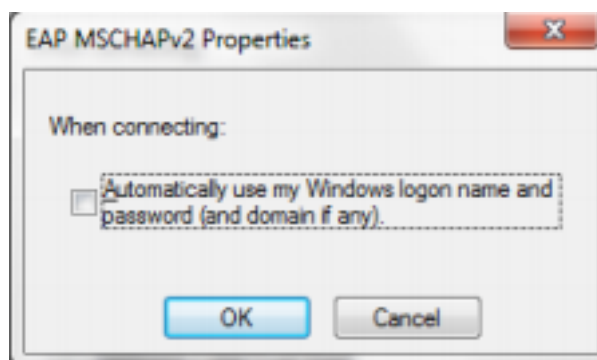
Select the **Security** tab and click **Settings** button



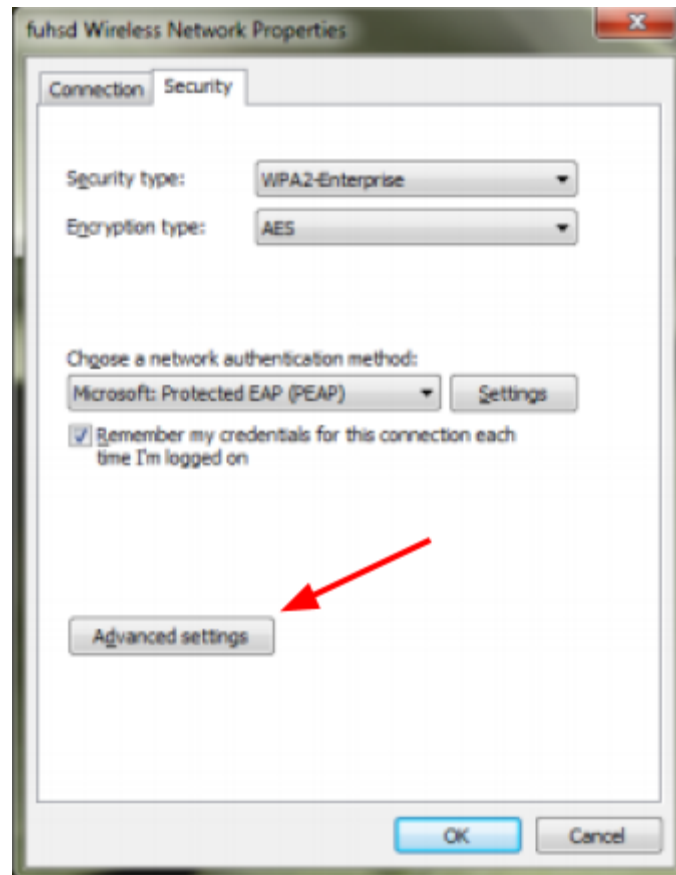
Uncheck **Validate server certificate**, then click **Configure**



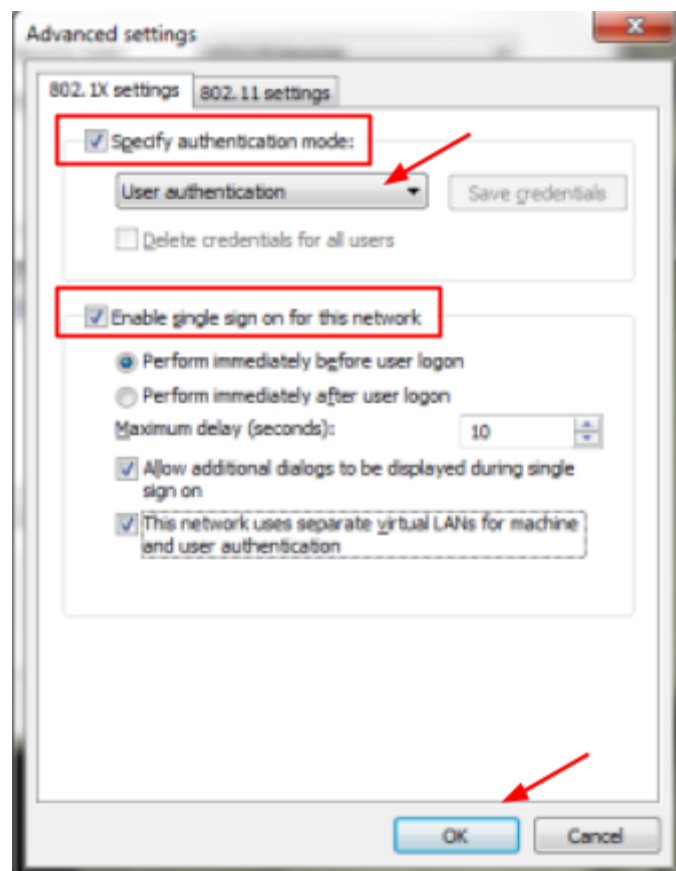
Uncheck **Automatically use my Windows logon name and password** and click OK. Click OK again.



Click **Advanced settings** button



Check **Specify authentication mode** and select **User authentication**, then check **Enable single sign on for this network** and click OK.



Now you should be able to connect to the “fuhsd” network by clicking on the wireless icon  again and selecting fuhsd. It will prompt you with a username and password. Type in your domain\student number (for example, hhs\123456) and your personal password (the password you would use to log on to a library computer.)

*Sometimes the connection does not establish itself the first time and the username and password may need to be attempted a second or third time. The connection process may also take up to a few minutes before it confirms it's connected to the internet.

Use **lynbrook\yourfuhsdid** as your username and the same password you use to log on to school computers.
