Wednesday, January 28:

- Mr. Brown and I will deliver a course selection overview during homeroom, outlining the process and highlighting key details. At that time, students will also receive their course selection worksheets.

Wednesday, February 4 - Tuesday, February 10:

- Teachers will spend class time discussing department course offerings, speaking with individual students regarding their recommendations, and signing the students' course selection worksheet.

Wednesday, February 11:

- Students will enter their course requests into Infinite Campus during homeroom using their completed, signed course selection worksheets.
- Homeroom teachers should collect the worksheets, and the assigned school counselor will come to the homerooms to retrieve them.

Tuesday, February 17 - Monday, March 2:

- Students schedule an appointment to meet with their school counselors to finalize their requests in Infinite Campus.
- Students will receive a printed copy of their course verification sheet from their school counselor for their parents' signature.

Thursday, March 12:

- Students MUST return their signed verification sheet to their school counselor by this date.
