

Educational Technology Graduate Student Council Officer Roles

Educational Technology Graduate Student Council is an official student organization. We work closely with the Learning Technologies program. 1) President

Responsibilities include attending a brief presidential training provided by the university, scheduling council meetings, planning event with council members.

The incoming president will receive mentorship and guidance in their transition to this role by our current president, Lin Lu (lu.962@osu.edu), who will remain on the council next year in a "Past President" role.

2) Vice President

Responsibilities include supporting the president in the above duties, helping to advertise events via the council's social media, and attending council meetings and events.

3) Treasurer

Responsibilities include attending a brief treasurer training provided by the university, submitting funding requests and receipts for reimbursement on the council's behalf, and attending council meetings and events. (Note: the treasurer will not be asked to provide their personal funds to be reimbursed. All funds for reimbursement will be handled through the council or university funds.)
