6	Conduct of players Dangerous play/ violent conduct	Students/leaders/staff	Medium	>Give three warnings, the final being to send the player off the alley. >This should be followed up with a chat about conduct within an activity			All Social staff.	
7	Physical injuries from normal play	Students/leaders/staff	Medium	>Players with injuries or medical complaints should let these be known to their leader before play			All Social staff.
