

Year 2 Planner – Lonely Planet

Topic (Geography and History)

As part of our Lonely Planet topic we will learn about the seven continents of the world. We will develop our natural curiosity and acquire the skills necessary to conduct research. We will name and locate the continents and oceans and will use aerial photographs to help us recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features around the world. We will explore aspects such as music, food, culture and famous people from around the world.

English

In English we will learn about the key features of non-chronological reports, including technical vocabulary, subheadings, captions and rhetorical questions. We will apply our knowledge in order to produce 'Lonely Planet' travel guides. We will also continue to develop our story writing, using stories from around the world. We will continue working on our phonic knowledge following the Read Write inc program. In addition to this we will also be focusing on our reading comprehension skills and looking to develop our ability to answer retrieval and inference questions based on a text.

Czech

V posledním termu se v rámci hodin češtiny zaměříme na souhrnné opakování učiva, psaní přepisu, opisu, diktátu a čtení s porozuměním. Procvičíme čtení a psaní skupin di-dy, ti-ty, ni-ny, bě, pě, vě, mě. Budeme se učit, jak pracovat s textem – vymyslíme různé alternativní konce příběhu a zkusíme je také napsat. V prvoUCE nás čeká tematický celek Člověk a čas, prozkoumáme krásy jarní přírody i lidské tělo. V hodinách matematiky si procvičíme porozumění slovním úlohám a budeme převádět digitální čas na analogový.

Mathematics

In Mathematics we will cover multiplication and division, followed by fractions including $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$. We will then move on to telling the time to half past/quarter past/to the hour and finding time durations. Finally we will cover statistics and position and direction. We will continue to develop fluency and recall of key number bonds and the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables using Times Tables Rock Stars and the 99 Club.

Science

This term we will begin by focusing on healthy eating and how to keep our bodies healthy. We will then move on to exploring the animal kingdom, learning about life cycles, food chains, adaptation and habitats.

Physical Education

In P.E. we will be moving outdoors and practising our athletic skills. We will also be taking part in some beach volleyball.

Computing

In Computing we will be expanding upon our Digital Literacy skills and looking at our behaviour and communication online. We will remind ourselves about SMART Rules and we will continue

working on developing our programming skills using a range of programmable robots.

Music

This term we will develop our ability to identify different sounds and to change and use sounds expressively in response to a stimulus. We will make a variety of sounds with our voices, bodies, found objects and instruments, and will explore how these sounds can be changed and used expressively in response to a stimulus.

Art

In Art we will learn about famous art and artists from around the world, further developing our knowledge of a range of techniques using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.

PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education)

Children will be learning about what helps us to grow and stay healthy. This unit looks at the importance of developing a healthy lifestyle, focussing particularly on how to create a healthy, balanced diet and why physical activity is essential. It also touches on other areas such as sleep, dental hygiene and hand washing.
