Phonebanking with Center for Common Ground/Reclaim Our Vote.

- Make calls to Virginia for their early voting days in advance of the November midterm election.
 - o Call infrequent Black voters and let them know HOW to vote....NOT WHO to vote for.
 - Fight voter suppression
 - Find everything you need here to make calls on your own or join a guided phonebank with a trainer.

- You don't write the entire letter...just a sentence or two about why you vote and the name and address on the envelope.
