Overview: Community Based Partner (CBP) Organizations who traditionally have offered field based experiences and on-site classroom based programs/assemblies are exploring different program pathway options for 2020-21. Below are some general trends and categories that have emerged as viable for the 2020-21 school year. The left side of the table has more opportunity for equity in access to programs for all students, but will take more coordination. Whereas, the right side has more opportunity to immediately remain viable as an organization, and requires less coordination.
