Recommended Practices to Amplify Community Engagement and Social Media Outreach

- 1. Place access to your online programs on the welcome page of your website.
- 2. Regularly post on Social Media (FB, IG, Twitter), short daily videos 3-15 minutes.

- 3. Interactive content including live trainings, special offers for upcoming programs, center and faculty bios with intro videos.
- 4. Host monthly open Zoom calls with the larger community, a gathering point for collective connection:
 - a. Value Offer: offer something specific to your community for free (a guided meditation, a lecture or something that will be valuable).
 - b. Lead Generation: at the end of the call invite the community to engage in your upcoming programs.
- 5. Share short videos on your YouTube channels.
- 6. Keep the website up-to-date with the opportunities to engage with current content, links to archives, blogs, videos, online trainings. Easy to engage content.





Recommended Practices for Online Programs

Start simple, start now - the world is looking for a genuine connection (not so much for a polished content). This is an incredible opportunity to gain experiential knowledge of creating online programs that will engage and grow your audience.

- LIVE Online Programs: Meditation, Yoga class and other teachings (with optional Q&A)
- RECORDED Teachings: to offer as a gift or for purchase
- Special pricing (incentives) you offer to your community.
- Referrals you request and rewards you offer for referrals (e.g. send one new student to a yoga class and receive your next class as a gift).
- Request written or video testimonials of your top classes and share on your website and Social Media with class offerings.
