Central California Legal Services (CCLS) is accepting applications from law students and recent law graduates from throughout the country for two paid summer ten-week fellowship positions. Each fellowship award will be in the amount of \$5,000. CCLS strongly encourages low-income students to apply. Bilingual ability in client languages is desirable but not required.

Applicants may propose projects that would increase access to justice for low-income residents of California's Central Valley. Proposed projects may focus on an area of substantive law of particular importance to low-income, Central Valley residents, including housing, health care, consumer rights and/or environmental justice. Proposals that address the structural causes of poverty in CCLS's service area are highly encouraged.
