

#A RESOLUTION

###to provide the Senate with an additional mechanism to guard against unfair interpretation of the Senate Rules

RESOLVED, by the United States Senate, that—

\*\*SECTION I. PROVISIONS\*\*

A. A new rule shall be added to the Rules of the 119th Senate, numbered Section 25 (or 26, as is appropriate) and labeled “Appeal to the Chair”, to read as follows;

>i. All decisions rendered by the Senate Majority Leader or President pro tempore regarding an interpretation of the rules shall be subject to a vote of the body as a whole, provided the Senator ruled against calls for such a vote, and the motion is seconded by an additional Senator of a different party. Should a majority of the Senate vote to overrule the Presiding Officer, the ruling shall be overturned, and the new ruling shall be binding precedent.
