
# Using the New Catalog - Baskets

This is our second quick and ugly handout. The first, "Using the New Catalog - some quick tips," focused on searching for things in the new catalog and placing holds on individual items. While the techniques explained in that handout are still valid, new features have been added. This means the catalog looks somewhat different... for now.

### The Main Page




#### Some things to look for:

- New Feature! Baskets! With the new catalog you can do things to lots of things at once... if you've put them in the basket. We'll explain more on the other side.
- The tiny downward arrows or triangles (circled above) indicate the *presence* of choices. Despite the inartful wording above, you don't have to painstakingly click on the tiny arrow itself to see the choices. Clicking on the box should suffice.
- However, some patrons have stated they had trouble signing in. They clicked on the
  "login" box and nothing happened. Actually they were clicking on the description next to
  the login box. The key is to look for the mouse's arrow to change to a little hand with a
  pointy finger. The little hand with a pointy finger means there is a link that will take you to
  another page.
- However, some patrons have stated they had trouble signing in even though they clicked on the proper box. The catalog said they don't have a proper pin. This is possible.
   Depending upon how their phone number was entered in the <u>old</u> catalog, it may not have generated a proper pin in the <u>new</u> catalog. If this is happening to you, call the Library (834-2281 x.2 or x.3) and we'll reset your pin.

### **Baskets**


Let's say you're in the mood for some David McCullough. You've read almost everything he's written, but nothing that he's done in the past five years or so. Your eyes are failing, so you want large print. After logging in, you do a keyword search for his name but limit the format to "Large Print." You get some results but you want his newest books, so you sort your results by "Date: newest to oldest." You click "Add to basket" next to the two newest books. Here is what you get:



Once American Spirit and Wright Brothers are nestled in the basket (you can see a little number next to it), choose "Place Holds" in the "Basket Actions" menu and then click "Go." Go to page 3 to see what you get.

## Placing the holds

Here's a screenshot of the final step. You can see both titles from the basket are listed. A notification method is chosen. Also, "Clear basket after holds are requested" is also checked. You don't have to do that. You do have to click on "Submit" at the very bottom or no holds will be placed despite all your work.



In the old catalog, you had to switch back and forth from your search and the place hold page many times. It was easy to lose track.
