* Enrollment for a Somersworth CTE Program:

Registration Process:

- Use **XELLO** to sign up during course registration.
- After signing up, you will be scheduled for an **interview** with the program teacher.

** Enrollment for a Dover or Rochester CTE Program:

Eligibility: Students entering grades 10, 11, or 12 MUST complete EnrollTrack to apply for a Dover or Rochester Program. Signing up does not guarantee enrollment.

- Students who have completed Year 1 and want to continue into Year 2 MUST also complete enrolltrack.

Extended Learning Opportunities (ELOs) allow students to earn credit through learning experiences that happen outside the traditional classroom. See your school counselor for more information. All linked forms are available in the counseling office.

GRADES: Pass/Fail and do not count toward GPA

CREDIT: Based on ELO Contract

Extended Learning Opportunities are for students looking to obtain credit based on an area of study that is not currently being offered as a course within the high school. These learning opportunities may include:

- [Teacher Aide-](#) Teacher Aides are learning experiences where students provide assistance to a classroom teacher. Duties can include, but are not limited to, assisting in the classroom, technology support, creating and maintaining visual classroom displays and lesson preparation. (Grade 12 only)
- [Independent Study-](#) Independent coursework is helpful for students who would like to expand their knowledge of a particular subject area of interest. This can include career exploration, advanced study, or project based learning opportunities.
- [Internship-](#) An internship is a temporary position where a student is paired with a professional in the community in order to gain practical experience in an occupation or profession.
- [VLACS/Online learning/Early College-](#) This option is for students who wish to take courses that are not offered at Somersworth High School. These may include enrichments, advanced level classes, or Early College. Additional information can be found in the Program of Studies.
- [Work Study-](#) This option is for students who request credit for employment opportunities. Students may earn up to one credit per year (Grade 11 and 12 Only).

Please note: Any student wishing to pursue an ELO should schedule a meeting with their school counselor **prior to the start of the marking term** where they will discuss options and receive recommendations, support, and appropriate paperwork.

- Retroactive extended learning opportunities will not be approved for credit

990 WORK-BASED LEARNING (CTE STUDENTS ONLY)

GRADE 11 & 12

1/2 CREDIT for 120 HOURS (1 credit max)

Work-Based Learning (WBL) opportunities apply academic, technical and employability skills in a work setting. Students will have a set schedule that would mirror a job which may be a semester or year long experience. WBL opportunities are typically paid. WBL can be performed during or after school or both. Paperwork and assistance can be found through the Career Technical Center.

PREREQUISITE: completion of the first year of CTE programming and program teacher recommendation/approval
