Officer Position Descriptions

Writer

- ★ Designated Director Board Member: Creative Director of Literary Arts & Director of Web Development
- ★ Responsibilities
 - Create a creative writing piece that expresses a personal story, an ongoing issue, or anything that you would like to express!
 - Preferably submit at least one work per month (or as assigned by the Director of Web Development).
 - Help write articles when necessary (approximately a 2-5 minute read).
 - Work with the Creative Director of Literary Arts & Director of Web Development to create any necessary writings for posts.
- ★ Requirements/Skills
 - Proficient experience in your style/preferred form of literature (poetry, fiction, nonfiction, drama, journalism, etc.)
 - Able to be organized and timely regarding literature submissions.
 - Communicate regularly with the Creative Director of Literary Arts & Director of Web Development to discuss progress and plans.

Social Media Manager *Only 7 Positions Available*

- ★ Designated Director Board Member: Communications Director
- ★ Responsibilities
 - Respond to direct messages and comments.
 - Reach out to other accounts asking to share our recent posts.
 - Repost informational activism posts, interesting creative arts posts, and other organization's posts on the story.
 - Share ideas for social media feed layout with the Executive Director and Directors of Graphic Design.
 - Figure out the best hashtags for each of our posts
 - Like and comment on the posts of accounts we follow.
 - Overall, increase social media activity and engage with our following!
 - Note: Do not follow back any accounts- the Executive/Communications Director will handle this.
- ★ Requirements/Skills
 - Proficient experience of how to use different social media such as Instagram, Tik Tok, Twitter, Facebook etc.

- Able to check the social media you are assigned to at least twice daily.
- Communicate regularly with the Communications Director to discuss progress and plans.
- Aesthetically gifted and able to create clean, appealing, and consistent stories for Creatively Asian.

Graphic Designer

★ Designated Director Board Member: Directors of Graphic Design

★ Responsibilities

- Design eye-catching graphics for Instagram posts and stories.
- Adhere to our set of graphic standards and ensure all graphics meet our qualifications.
- Create innovative and artistic graphics that emphasize ongoing issues in the world to help inform our community.
- Work with the Directors of Graphic Design to create any necessary graphic designs for posts.

★ Requirements/Skills

- Proficient knowledge of Canva, Photoshop, Procreate or other digital art programs.
- Able to be organized and timely regarding graphic design submissions.
- Communicate regularly with the Director of Graphic Design to discuss progress and plans.
- Aesthetically gifted and able to create clean, appealing, and consistent graphic designs for Creatively Asian.
- Able to adapt to Creatively Asian branding/graphic design style
- Able to aid the Directors of Graphic Design by creating at least one graphic post every two weeks.
- Able to designate at least 5 hours per month to Creatively Asian graphic designs.

Illustrator

★ Designated Director Board Member: Directors of Graphic Design

★ Responsibilities

- Create innovative and artistic illustrations that address ongoing issues in the world to help inform our community on such topics.

- Preferably submit at least two works per month (some of which will be assigned by the Director of Graphic Design, but you may also submit your own personal work).
 - Create artwork to accompany any articles written by our writers
 - Work with the Directors of Graphic Design to create any necessary illustrations for posts, fundraiser promotions, merchandise designs, etc.
- ★ Requirements/Skills
- Proficient knowledge of digital drawing platforms like Procreate or programs.
 - Proficient experience in your style/preferred form of artform (painting, drawing, sketching, etc).
 - Able to be organized and timely regarding illustration submissions.
 - Communicate regularly with the Director of Graphic Design to discuss progress and plans.
 - Aesthetically gifted and able to create clean, appealing, and consistent illustrations for Creatively Asian.
 - Able to designate at least 5 hours per month to Creatively Asian illustrations.

Editor

- ★ Designated Director Board Member: Creative Director of Literary Arts & Director of Web Development
- ★ Responsibilities
- Work closely with the Creative Director of Literary Arts & Director of Web Development to edit articles, descriptions, captions, etc.
 - Help word items effectively and efficiently to allow the audience to easily understand the message.
- ★ Requirements/Skills
- Proficient experience in writing and literature.
 - Proficient experience with grammar rules and Grammarly.

- Help coordinate workshops, podcasts, and any other projects assigned by the Creative Director of Projects & Initiatives.

 - Brainstorm creative fundraising opportunities that are relevant to the Creatively Asian message and incorporate the arts.
 - Think of ways to maximize the impact that our organization can make.
 - Help create promotional materials for these fundraisers, with the help of the Directors of Graphic Design, such as Instagram posts and stories.
