STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHAT IS SAP?

- The Student Assistant Program is designed to help direct and access school and community resources for students found to be in need. All information is confidential.

WHO CAN MAKE A REFERRAL?

- ANYONE - Most referrals come from the student's teachers and/or parents. The student may also make a referral if he/she feels the need for help.

HOW DOES A STUDENT BECOME INVOLVED IN THE PROGRAM?

- Our team will help you find services and assistance with the school and, if needed, in the community. We do not diagnose, treat, or refer your child for treatment. Rather, we will provide you with information. YOU make the choices.

WHAT IF SOMEONE HAS ALREADY REFERRED MY CHILD TO THE PROGRAM?

- First, know that your child was referred because someone is concerned about observable changes they are seeing in your child. Perhaps a teacher or friend has noticed changes in behavior and habits you may or may not have noticed at home.
- The SAP team will request that you sign a permission form for your child to become involved in the program. Once you sign, the SAP Team will begin to work with you and your child. If you feel you need more information before making a decision, please let your SAP Team know. If you do not sign the permission form the SAP Team will not become involved. Participation is voluntary.

THE SAP PROCESS

WHO IS INVOLVED?

- The core SAP Team is made up of specially trained school and community personnel that work together with the parents/guardians to locate resources that will benefit the needs of the student.
