GENERAL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How do I log-in to my Naviance account?

NAVIANCE:

If you have previously registered on Naviance.

Enter your required information:

- Username: School email address
- **Password:** 6-digit lunch account # (if your lunch account is 5 digits add a 0 at the end of the number).

If you have not yet registered, click on "*I need to register*" in the top right-hand corner and enter your registration code given by your counselor. This will allow you to enter your preferred email address and password to enter the site.

If you forgot your username and/or password, stop by the Counseling Department in your building.

What is the Naviance Family Connection?

Family Connection from Naviance is a web-based service designed especially for students and parents. Family Connection is a comprehensive website that you can use to help in making decisions about colleges and careers. Family Connection is linked with the Counseling Department. It is a service that we use to track and analyze data about college and career plans so we can provide up-to-date information to our students.

How do you register for courses online?

Who is my counselor?

How do I access my PowerSchool account?

Access the <u>BTSD WEBSITE</u>: click the picture of the high school. Click the **Students** tab, scroll down, and click PowerSchool Student Portal.

Enter your required information:

- User ID: Student's lunch Account #
- **Password:** Use the student created /uses to access the internet in class.
