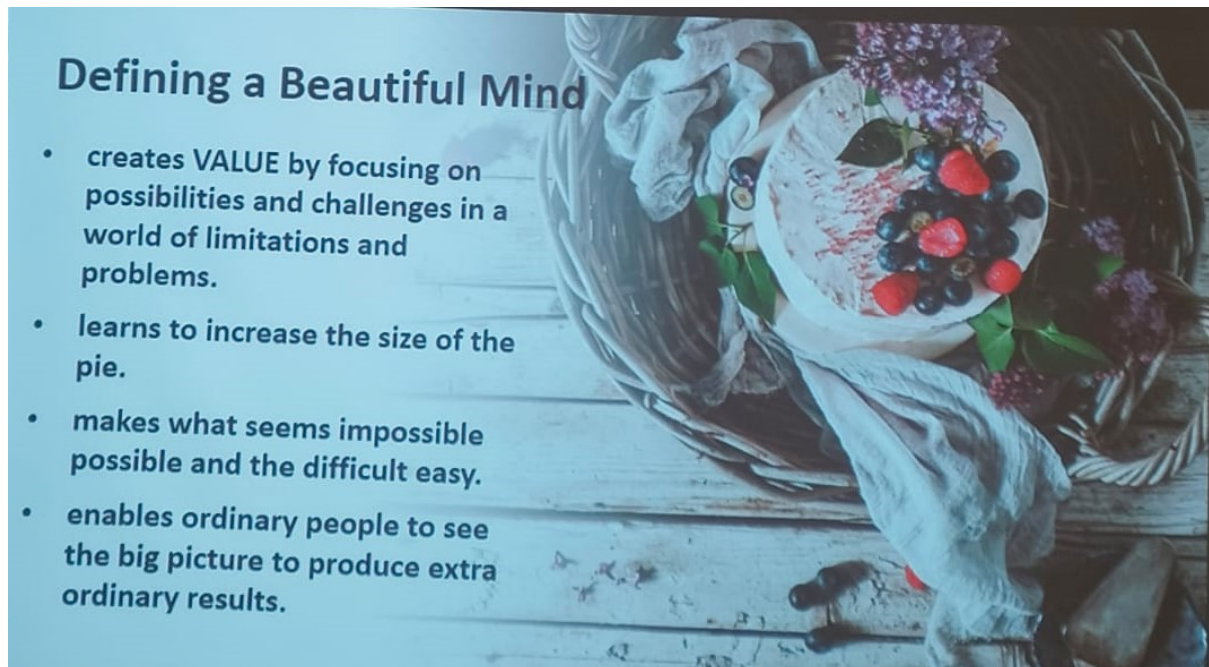
INTERACTIVE WORKSHOP ON BUILDING BEAUTIFUL MINDS
