## Section 1, Addressing the Prime Minister.

To Prime Minister Reinhardt Weiss. I have received your document, where you make your **embarrassing** motion to remove me from office. This is a shadow of the former attempt on my employment from the same office. I remind you of the responsibilities **YOU** must abide by. You **falsely** make a remark that I oppose the authorities given to the federal council and its ministers, while you don't even understand **your own authority**.

As a reminder of the Crown Mandate, Article 5, section B. "Ministers, appointed to serve as members of the Federal Council, shall hold their positions unless a **clear** and **justifiable** reason for their removal is presented." You, *Prime Minister* may not remove people for doing their jobs, and not bending over to your misjudged authority. *What* authorities do I oppose? *What* specifically did I hinder? Instead of calling me a runt you could mayhap attend a seminar on giving more details. Until you fulfill your duties in the Crown Mandate;

- 1. I, **Dirk Bürger** will not recognize my removal from the Prime Minister until the following is set in place;
  - a. A **clear** and **justifiable** reason for my removal is presented.
  - b. A letter is sent to the Emperor, documenting my removal and the process thereof, with proof or confirmation of said letter being sent.
  - c. Due Process is upheld.
- 2. I, **Dirk Bürger**, will retain the entirety of the title **Minister of Truth and Society** until due process is completely fulfilled.
