



1. Fold in half a 4- $\frac{1}{4}$ "x11" piece of Basic Black cardstock.
2. Use a Stampin' Sponge to apply Soft Suede ink to the edges of a 5- $\frac{1}{4}$ "x4" piece of Parisian Blossoms Designer Series Paper (DSP). Glue to card base.
3. Use Stampin' Sponge to apply Soft Suede ink to a 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ "x5- $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of Petal Pink cardstock. Stamp script image from Parisian Beauty using Petal Pink ink. Run a line of SNAIL along the back left side and adhere 5- $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of Very Vanilla Scalloped Lace Trim. Tie Petal Pink Metallic-Edge Ribbon around finished piece and adhere to card.

4. Use Stampin' Sponge to lightly apply Soft Suede ink all over 2"x3-3/4" piece of Parisian Blossoms DSP. Glue to 2-1/8"x3-7/8" Basic Black cardstock. Glue to finished piece to card.
5. Stamp Eiffel Tower image in Memento Tuxedo Black ink on Pool Party cardstock. Die-cut with Eiffel Tower outline die from Parisian dies. Glue to card with Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Die-cut "merci" from Basic Black cardstock and use Fine-Tip Glue Pen to adhere to card.
7. Add Champagne Rhinestones with Take Your Pick Tool.
