Late Policy

Purpose

The late policy describes the deduction applied to grading of submissions past the submission deadline.

Late Submissions

Assignments submitted after the deadline are late.

Submission Deadline

Submission deadlines are set by the instructors.

Submission deadlines might be extended by the instructor.

Students can petition to extend the submission deadline for family emergencies, out of town job interviews or conference presentations where the student presents a paper or poster.

Students cannot petition to extend the submission deadline because of workload created by other courses or professional obligations.

No petitions are accepted after the deadline has passed.

Counting the Amount of Delay

Each laboratory day after the submission deadline is counted as a single day late. Laboratories are open as indicated on the course website. If the submission deadline was Sunday, a submission on the first day when the laboratory is open is one day late and so on.

Deductions

On a grading scale of 0 to 100, for each day late, there will be a 10-point deduction to the grade. Two days late will result in a 20 points deduction. The maximum deduction is 30 points. The deduction will be adjusted proportionally if the grading is on another scale.
