- Ford Foundation Fellowship Programs
  - Eligibility:
    - All U.S. citizens, U.S. nationals, and U.S. permanent residents (holders of a Permanent Resident Card); individuals granted deferred action status under the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals Program; Indigenous individuals exercising rights associated with the Jay Treaty of 1794; individuals granted Temporary Protected Status; asylees; and refugees, regardless of race, national origin, religion, gender, age, disability, or sexual orientation
    - Individuals with evidence of superior academic achievement (such as grade point average, class rank, honors or other designations); and
    - Individuals committed to a career in teaching and research at the college or university level in the U.S.

### • Mediaocean's Women in Tech Scholarships

- Eligibility:
  - Applicants must be female full- or part-time, current or prospective graduate or undergraduate students studying science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) at an accredited US university or college.
  - Applicants must be 18 years of age or older as of October 15 of the year before the deadline.
- Women Chemists Committee/Eli Lilly Travel Award
  - Eligibility:
    - Open to women.
    - Can be at the graduate or postdoctoral level.
    - Preference will be given to any applicant who will be making her first presentation (regardless of format) at a national or major meeting.
- American Dissertation Fellowship
  - Eligibility:
    - American Fellowship candidates must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents.
    - American Fellowships are open to scholars who identify as women in all fields of study.
    - The American Dissertation Fellowship must be used for the final year of writing the dissertation.
