Good morning,

We are excited to announce that Community Solutions has acquired the first property needed to end veteran homelessness in Jacksonville. Jacksonville-Duval, Clay Counties CoC is part of Built for Zero, a national movement to measurably end homelessness.

As part of the Built for Zero movement, the community has created a coordinated team that has developed a real-time, by-name list of every veteran experiencing homelessness. From that list, they are able to see, in real-time, how many veterans need housing.

As of April 26, 192 veterans were on Jacksonville's real-time, by-name list. Of those veterans, 120 currently have a housing resource, such as a housing voucher or subsidy, and are looking for an available unit. However, there is not enough supply to move the qualified veterans into housing. Acquiring Caroline Village will help close that supply gap and provide local, permanent housing and wrap-around services.
