









Some Chrome Tools for Collecting/Storing and Organizing Content

The tools in this document work using the Google Chrome Web Browser and on Chromebooks unless otherwise indicated.

Tool	Key Features	Comments
<p><u>Diigo Web Collector</u></p>  <p>Free Chrome Extension</p> <p>Need to create an account.</p> <p><u>https://www.diigo.com/tools/chrome_extension</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bookmark web pages - annotate using sticky notes and highlighting - add tags - outliner feature lets you collect, organize and share information 	
<p><u>Dropbox</u></p>  <p>App Free, \$</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - store files of all types (docs, images, PDFs, etc.) - view files, no ability to edit Office documents, PDFs 	App takes you to the Dropbox website.
<p><u>Evernote</u></p>  <p>App Free, \$</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - store files of all types (docs, images, PDFs, audio files, etc.) - save links to web sites, videos - create notes 	Syncs with Evernote on other platforms, devices
<p><u>Google Keep</u></p>  <p>App Free</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - add notes, create checklists, add photos, audio - color code content - filter and search functions - ability to share/collaborate - push notes out to Docs - bring notes into Docs and Slides 	Syncs with Keep on other platforms, devices
<p><u>GoogleTrek</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - tied to Google Maps - teachers or students create content on a topic that can embed text, web links, 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - needs a little initial explanation: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the standard map links are at the bottom of each link (directions, etc.)

 <p>website Free</p>	<p>photos, audio and video</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - there are a lot of already created Treks by teachers and students, by curricular area, grade level; can add yours 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - can accidentally zoom or move around the map and lose the visual display - best if navigating via the left window pane
<p>Permanent Clipboard</p>  <p>Chrome extension Free</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - save clipboard elements that you frequently need to access - give the element a name - insert from contextual menu 	<p>This works differently than others in this document. Just saves pieces of text that you re-use often, saving you from having to go looking for it or retyping it.</p>
<p>Scrible</p>  <p>Chrome extension Free</p> <p>Need to create an account Can sign in with Google</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - bookmark sites - create tags - highlight - annotate, comment - store files - share items, real time annotations - integrates with Google Doc - capture citations and create bibliographies - compile your annotations across articles in a single summary or report (\$) - can share libraries to collaborate on projects, etc. (\$) - get additional storage space (start with 500 MB) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - similar to Dropbox, you can earn additional storage space by inviting others to join Scrible.
<p>TabCloud</p>  <p>Chrome Extension Free</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - lets you save groups of collected tabs (e.g. when researching a topic, doing a presentation) and restore all the tabs later and/or on other devices
