- NOTE** - In order to graduate, students are required to complete a minimum of 42 hours from Harding courses numbered 3000-4999.
- NOTE** - Any course taken through ASU-Beebe that is listed as equating for a 3000 level course, will transfer as a lower level equivalent version of that course when completed as part of this articulation agreement.
- NOTE** - Both HIST 1013 and HIST 1023 transfers as elective HIST hours. However, it will substitute for either HIST 2100 or HIST 2110 when students complete the associates degree as part of this articulation agreement.
- NOTE** - Students are required to complete a minimum of 150 hours in order to sit for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) Exam.
- NOTE** - Additional semester Bible courses may be required which will increase overall hours.
