SCHEDULING RELEASE PERIODS POLICY

Late Arrival/Early Release Policy	CCP Release Policy
Juniors and seniors are eligible for early release or late arrival with completion of the early dismissal/late arrival form signed by a parent/guardian. This form must be submitted with a student's course request form.	Juniors and seniors taking an online CCP class are eligible for release during their free period with parent/guardian permission on file. A CCP Release form must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian, and it must be submitted along with the student's course request form.

EDUCATIONAL OPTIONS

College Credit Plus (CCP)	Flex Credit
College Credit Plus (CCP) allows students to take college courses that count for both high school and college credit. Credits earned transfer to all public colleges and universities in Ohio. Students in CCP must meet college-level expectations and perform at the same level as other college students.	The Flex Credit Program allows students in grades 9–12 to earn high school credit by demonstrating mastery of standards or competencies instead of relying on classroom seat time. Students follow an approved plan and develop skills that meet graduation requirements and prepare them for 21st-century demands.

COURSE CHANGE POLICY

Schedule Change Policy	Course Drop Policy
Choose your courses carefully, as changes can affect class sizes, teacher assignments, and the overall schedule. Requests for changes can be made through the School Counseling office until March 2, 2026 . After this date, changes will only be allowed for summer school completion, technical errors, academic misplacement, scheduling conflicts, or if a student does not have 5 credits.	Students may drop a course without penalty until the 23rd school day of a semester class or the end of the first quarter for a year-long class. The course will be replaced with a study hall. Students must maintain the required 5 credit class load. Dropping a course after the deadline will result in an “F” on the transcript and will be included in the GPA. Students and parents/guardians should meet with the teacher and school counselor if this situation arises.
