

Science Class Routines & Expectations



1. *Come to class prepared
 - a. Bring the following materials to every science class:
 - i. 1-2 inch binder with inside pockets (No larger ones please.) with 5 dividers & about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a pack of filler paper (You can add as needed.)
 - ii. Planner
 - iii. Composition notebook
 - iv. Pencil Case
 1. Pencils with erasers
 2. Highlighters (Preferably different colors)
 3. Pens (black or blue, and at least one other color for corrections)
 4. Scissor
 5. Post-it-notes (different colors)
 6. Earbuds for computer use

*Please check your materials each weekend to make sure you have everything you need to learn your best the following week.

**Your composition notebook for Science Journaling will remain in the classroom.

2. BE ON TIME! We are working on a tight schedule and much Science fun awaits you. Leave all Non-Science materials in your switch bag on the hook in the hallway. Check the whiteboard outside the classroom door for reminders. When you enter the classroom, go to your seat and take out materials for Science. Science materials you are not using should be inside the cubby of your lab table.

3. Check the screen for the class agenda:
 - The Daily Check-in Slideshow posted on Google Classroom will be projected on the screen. Here you will find a link to the Google Classroom Site, as well as the day's topic and activities.
 - Homework is updated daily on Google Classroom Site. You are also encouraged to use your planner, Google Keep, or Google Calendar to map out the week/month for all of your classes. Find a system that works for you!

4. During class discussion, **please do not speak when others are speaking**. Raise your hand and wait to be called on. Speak loudly and clearly. We want to hear everyone's ideas and thoughts.

5. Students with **positive fun attitudes** make a positive fun classroom. Don't blame others for problems; help one another fix problems. We all make mistakes, and we all have something to offer.

6. Please **ask questions!** If you have more questions than we have time to answer, write them down and they will be answered at a later time.

7. When providing an answer, make sure it is detailed and that you can provide evidence. **BE SPECIFIC!**

8. Clean up after yourself. Return items to where you found them. Students will be dismissed once the teachers have checked each table. Cubbies are for storage, not trash.

9. If you have questions about an assignment, quiz, assessment, lab, or project, **please ask**. Do not wait until the night before it is due or minutes before the test.

10. Always give your best effort. Assume anything we are working on may be graded.
