

Alternatives to Work Off Citizenship (U's)

Remove 1 (one) U with one or more of the following. ***Students will be responsible to fill out the Citizenship Contract and get appropriate signatures.*** Once the U has been cleared with one of the following, the student must take the signed Citizenship Contract to the office, along with \$10 per U fee, to clear.

1. **Parent/Student Complete “Strengthening Families” Virtual Class:** see [FLYER](#) for details on completing this 6 week class, online and self-paced class.
2. **Attend ACT Boot Camp Week:** Have teachers sign citizenship contract documenting each day of attendance.
3. **Participate in Blood Drive:** Have Mrs Christensen sign citizenship contract verifying your participation. Can not have BOTH U removed and extra credit in her class. Must choose 1.
4. **Attend 4 Hours of Tutoring:** Student documents time on Citizenship Contract. Teachers who provide tutoring will sign citizenship contract once student has completed 4 hours.
5. **Attend 3 Extra Canvas Seminars** (beyond the required 6 per year): Students must submit their own assignments, then ask the Counselor to sign citizenship contract.
6. **Attend Night of Hope:** Students will need to choose whether they have one U removed OR if they use it for extra credit. There will be QR code at end of event to choose
7. **Create a Contract with Counselor or Administration** with one of the following:
 - a. GPA Improvement by 0.50 or more
 - b. Attendance Improvement – No U's in the next term or has no absences in that term
 - c. Academic Credit Recovery – students who complete one term of credit recovery can have 1 U removed for each
8. **Work with Teacher who Issued U:** Teacher can work out a deal with students who received a U to make it up. This can be done through extra help or work after school or at teacher's discretion. Teacher is not required to offer this.
9. **Citizenship Make-Up Class** (various dates-See Canvas Seminar)
