

Career Week Lesson: Career Dress-Up Guessing Game

Theme: Dress Like Your Future

Objective

Students will explore different careers by observing and guessing classmates' future jobs. This activity helps students understand that their interests and passions can turn into careers.

Lesson Introduction

Explain to students that many people choose careers based on things they enjoy doing or care about. Today they will help guess each other's future careers!

Activity: Career Dress-Up Guessing Game

1. Invite one student at a time to come to the front of the room.
2. The student gives 1–2 clues about their job (for example: 'I help sick people' or 'I build houses').
3. The class raises hands to guess the career.
4. After guesses, the student reveals their career.
5. Teacher briefly explains what that job does and how it helps people.

Examples of Clues

- I help animals stay healthy. (Veterinarian)
- I build houses and buildings. (Construction worker / Builder)
- I help people learn new things. (Teacher)
- I help keep people safe. (Police officer / Firefighter)
- I fix cars and machines. (Mechanic)

Closing Discussion

- What careers did we learn about today?
- How do these jobs help people?
- What are some things you love doing that could become a job someday?

Remind students: Every student has different strengths and passions. There are many different paths they can take in the future.
