ELIGIBILITY: Grade 9-12

**If the individual is upgrading their grade 12 year (5th year of High School) and

is a first year Junior, this will not be accepted.

Spectators: \$15.

RULES: Elite: Modified rules: 2x3 min periods. Only 1 turn allowed on ground. Pin adds an extra 2 points. 10 points superiority finishes the match. RUN time. If

tournament is running slower than expected then matches will drop to 2x2 min

periods with last 30s seconds stop time.

Takedown tournament for Novice 2×2 min periods. Run time. If tournament is

running slower than expected then matches will drop to 3 min periods with last

30s stop time.

- Takedown to control or directly to the back scores 1 point.

- Pin scores 1 extra point but can only be completed if back exposure is from the



takedown and exposure is not lost prior to the pin

- 6 point differential is considered technical superiority and ends the match Both Divisions:

No west point holds, no back bending throws.

All wrestlers must be a member of their provincial wrestling association

WEIGHTS: - Round Robin pools of 4 (where possible) or Nordic draw when possible.

Athlete pooled based on experience (elite 3rd or 4th year/novice 1st or 2nd)

WEIGH-INS: At home weigh-in. Weights inputted by Tuesday Nov 25th.

REGISTRATION: Each team will receive an e-mail with their personal login details upon confirmation of intent to attend.
