### Intro

Calypso Sakuri is the main protagonist in *Calypso And The Sunnyside*. She plays a major part in the story because of this, and they have a lot of chapter-like episodes dedicated to them.

### Appearance

Calypso's appearance changes ever so slightly throughout the series, but most of the time she is seen with black hair(while sometimes it is portrayed as sunlit rather than the actual black color itself) with glasses, freckles, and a few stickers. Calypso also has dark blue eyes and usually wears a black shirt with either a jacket over it or a vest. She wears black shorts and black thigh high shoes. She sometimes wears a cross necklace(for reasons why, see trivia). Calypso's skin is seen as pale, but not too pale. Sometimes, Calypso wears bracelets or fingerless gloves to hide what's underneath...(to see what she hides, see trivia).

### Personality

Calypso is portrayed as curious and kind, and she's always willing to help others. However, she doesn't attach to others much(except to those she knew long enough) and can let go easily. She's also very insecure and depressed and pessimistic, despite seeming optimistic all the time.

### Lore

Calypso was born on September 20th of 2009 and the story of the actual thing takes place between 2024-2026. The whole thing began in elementary school(who we will use "He/Him" or "They/Them" and refer to as Calvin for now because she's AMAB). In 2015, Calvin noticed how others used "He/Him" on him. He thought "That's not right! I don't like being called that." So Calvin told his dad, and his dad told him "That's because you are a boy, Calvin. And you always will be. God made you the way you are, and you should accept it." As Calvin grew older, the

feeling of disliking those pronouns stayed, and in middle school, he noticed something, how he saw girls being used "she/her" on them, and he thought "I want to be like them!" So he started dressing femininely (by feminine I mean wearing skirts and using extensions), but they started to get bullied a lot in school for it, and one boy named Henry even told them that they were a boy and always will be. Eventually, their dad found out and "beat the girly out of him and put in holy spirit", implying that their dad abused them and forced religion on them. Eventually, Calvin stopped wearing skirts and extensions and just suffered in silence. They walked to the roof, where they would "finally be free", implying a suicide attempt. But they found a girl named Willow there, where she would confront them, telling them that it was normal to change yourself. Willow then gave Calvin a bow and said "Here, so you can be who you truly are inside!", and ever since, Calvin began dressing femininely again and started going by "Calypso", and went by she/her during this time (the they/them pronouns came in late middle school) and her life was normal until high school, specifically the last day, and when she returned from school, she found that her parents were missing. She looked everywhere, but then she saw her brother covered in blood, so she ran off with her brother following her, and then she fell into a portal which led to a large city, where she meets Rowan Hana. Rowan takes her in and introduces her to London Hana. After their bickering, Rowan and London agree to give Calypso a tour, and then Calypso asks if there's more to this world, and Rowan explains about the Sunnyside, and London tells the tale of Kitsuna and Haikurae who went to the Sunnyside and got cannibalized, Kitsuna by the Beheading Execution Practice (written as 斬首刑の執行実習), and Haikurae by Seppuku (A Japanese Samurai Suicide Ritual), but the two agree to go to the Sunnyside. On the adventure, they fight a lot of people, but they make it in the end, and in the end of Season-book 1, the Episode-like chapter, "Change Your Mind", Calypso has to make a decision whether to stay or leave, but Calypso chooses to stay. In season-book 2, two new friends join the adventure, Willow Saki, Calypso's friend, and Benjamin Sakuri, Calypso's brother. The five go on hilarious adventures, but the innocent days fade away when a massacre occurs. Calypso tries her best to fight and save everyone, but in the final episode-like chapter of season-book 2, "Goodbye London" when she's about to get killed by a mysterious individual, London sacrifices her life to save Calypso, and she is devastated. They manage to fight off the individual (but he comes back later unfortunately :( ) and Calypso straightens out her hair as a way to show her difference in grief (This represents how she's all poofy, silly, and cool when London is alive, but depressed and quiet when London dies). In season-book 3, Calypso tries to save the rest of her friends from dying, but there's a moment where Rowan and Benjamin end up falling for each other and kissing, but in this scene, Benjamin is shot in the neck by the same individual who killed London. Rowan doesn't notice until he starts to taste blood. Rowan and Calypso are baffled that this happened. Benjamin is then kidnapped by this individual. Calypso, Rowan, and Willow do their best to track down this individual, but doesn't find him anywhere until the individual appears in the last episode-like chapter of season-book 3, "WITCH", and Calypso fights back out of anger, and she shoots an arrow at the individual's face. Afterwards, Calypso decides to take a photo of Rowan and Willow to remember them if they die in the massacre. But then a grenade rolls at Rowan's feet, and it explodes. Calypso's hair is chopped off to the shoulders by a sword that's been stabbed on a tree, and a bit of her arm's skin is cut off a bit. Calypso and Rowan survive, but whether Willow also survives is unknown until season-book 4. In season-book 4, Calypso gets more depressed, because she has found out that Willow is now dead. Calypso

tries her best to fight with Rowan the best she can, and the individual comes around again, but is now identified as Henry, but only to Rowan. Calypso and Rowan try to fight him off once again, but the individual keeps fighting back, but then, Calypso fires a pistol at his leg. The individual doesn't come back until the last episode-like chapter, "Ghost Flower", when at the festival for the remaining survivors, Henry outs Calypso about being transgender in front of Rowan. Calypso is scared, embarrassed, and angry, and runs away. Rowan tries to follow after her, but she loses him. In season-book 5, Calypso now begins fighting on her own. Calypso gathers an army and makes them help her fight back. One day, Henry tells both Rowan and Calypso that the other is dead, though it is false information. But the other believes it and thinks hope is lost. Calypso begins acting more aggressive, but in the final episode-like chapter of season-book 5, the final episode-like chapter of the series, "Did You Miss Me?" Calypso and Henry are pinned against each other. Henry almost kills Calypso, but Calypso says that she'll still have him even when everything is lost. Henry is shocked, but then his neck is slit by an unknown stranger. Henry dies, and the stranger says he is Rowan. Calypso tries to get away from him, but Rowan tells her that he still accepts her no matter what. Calypso eventually warms up to him again. Rowan tells her that he has an ability to bring everyone who died back, and next thing you know, Benjamin, Willow, London, and even Henry is alive. Henry tries to be a better person, and the massacre is over now, and Calypso stays in the universe for the rest of her life. What happens next is up to the sequel, *Sunnyside's Up!*.

## Relationships

### ***Rowan Hana***

Rowan and Calypso have a strong bond, and are really good friends. Calypso has seen to appreciate his advice whenever she gets it, and gives him advice when he needs it in return. Calypso enjoys Rowan's company a lot.

### ***Willow Saki***

Calypso and Willow are dating, and there's no way to deny it. They've kissed each other, blushed in a romantic way when they flirt, and they even have confirmed to almost sacrifice themselves to save the other.

### ***London Hana***

London and Calypso don't interact much, mainly due to adventure separation, but the times they've interacted, they seem to really like to joke. They've said joking stuff to each other and loved to prank Rowan before the massacre.

### ***Henry/Individual A***

Henry and Calypso have been enemies until the sequel to the series. There's not much about their relationship. We just know they hate each other.

### ***Benjamin Sakuri***

Calypso and Benjamin are siblings, but Calypso has a love-hate relationship with him. She doesn't like him, but will still protect him because he's the only one who saved her all these years.

#### Trivia

- Calypso's favorite color is orange
- Calypso is a queer Christian
- Calypso is lesbian
- Calypso doesn't have a preference for her pronouns, you can call her either she/her or they/them, but only four people call them by "they" (Benjamin, Willow, and London. Rowan joins not far behind after season-book 5)
- Calypso would probably bring her Bible to an ouija board game (and be completely booed of it by London)
- Calypso self harms, but is currently two months clean.
- If Calypso didn't find the alternate dimension, she would've become a makeup artist
- One thing that gives Calypso gender euphoria is eyeshadow (she says it makes her look feminine)
- Calypso's favorite vegetable is carrots, and her favorite food is strawberries.


