#### Who is Eligible:

- ✓ Only students who *currently* live in the 46th District of Maryland are eligible to apply. You can look up where you live by entering your address here: [mdelect.net](http://mdelect.net).
- ✓ Only students who plan to attend a Maryland college or university or a private career school are eligible. Private career schools must have the Maryland

Higher Education Commission's approval to operate and must be accredited by a national accrediting association approved by the U.S. Department of Education. You may also attend a nursing school if the Commission approves the curriculum.

- ✓ Part-time or full-time students are eligible.
- ✓ Undergraduate and graduate students are eligible; however, *preference is given to undergraduate students*.
- ✓ You may use this scholarship at an out-of-state school if your major is not available at a Maryland school. The Office of Student Financial Assistance must verify your major is unique. Please call 410-767-3155 for more information.

1. Complete the written application questionnaire below
2. Attach the following documents with your completed application:
  - a. A copy of your complete Student Aid Report to very submission of your FAFSA. \*EXCEPTION: students who are ineligible to receive federal financial aid through FAFSA may submit their Maryland State Financial Aid application (MFSAA).
  - b. Unofficial copy of your most recent academic transcript – high school or college.
  - c. A screenshot of mdelect.net showing your address is in the 46<sup>th</sup> District
  - d. Letters of recommendation & recommender contact information (at least one letter of recommendation is required).
3. Submit application in of the following two ways:
  - a. Mail your COMPLETE application with all the documents above to **Delegate Luke Clippinger's office** by May 1, 2022. It must be postmarked no later than May 1 to be considered.
