

Dollaske Region - Round 1

#1 Palmer Ault vs. Fishers	#16 Garrett Poytner vs. Carmel
This goal was great. The conditions made it even better. Less than 4 minutes to go in a 1-1 game against a bitter rival in Fishers. Brayden Doll took the free kick from the right flank. He played it toward the top of the penalty area. Drew Barnes went up for a header but even with his 6'3" frame the ball was too high. Cole Bramblett chased it down and put a 1 touch cross / shot back on goal. It went over the goalie's outstretched hands and hit the far post. Palmer Ault alertly dove and put a header on the ball to win the game 2-1 and keep our conference championship hopes alive. The fans cheering near the corner flag also knew the importance of this play.	Not seen in the video is Garrett earning the penalty kick himself. He made a great weak side run towards the penalty spot. As the cross came in, the defender had no choice but to foul him. As for the penalty kick itself, Garrett calmly stepped up the spot and buried the PK to the lower right as the keeper guessed lower left. Also seen in the video, Drew Barnes "scoring" again. It was a habit of Drew's to make sure his teammates scored. See how many times you can spot this occurrence.

#8 Palmer Ault vs. Greenfield - Central	#9 Drew Barnes vs. Greenfield - Central
The play starts with Spencer Holland taking a great first touch in towards the center of the pitch to beat the first defender. He then sends a pass up to Palmer Ault. The pass is slightly behind Ault but he does a great job gaining control and still having the speed to race past the backline defender. He then slots a low shot past the GK.	Great distribution from our GK Nick Johnson to play wide to Spencer Holland. Spencer lets the ball travel through him so he can take one touch and "send himself". He uses his blazing speed to travel the entire offensive half of the pitch. He sends a low cross into the box. The G-C goalie thinks he can get it, but Drew Barnes cuts in to find the end of Holland's cross and slot it into the back of the net. This was the official first goal of the 2020 season.

#4 Cameron Jarrett vs. Muncie Central	#13 Palmer Ault vs. Greenfield - Central
The play starts with an endline cross from Jordan Hindes. The cross had a little too much weight as it goes through the penalty area untouched. The Millers control on the far flank and send another cross into the area that is going to land right at the penalty spot. Cameron Jarrett attacks the cross, rises up and hits a great header over the MC goalie just as contact comes from the defender.	The play starts with a throw-in from Cole Bramblett and the rest is all Palmer Ault. He first dummies the ball which freezes the defenders. Then he dribbles to the 18 which pulls the keeper out and then he slots a nice shot low, far post.

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#5 Drew Cochran vs. Muncie Central	#12 Palmer Ault vs. Carroll
After going into halftime being only up 3-0 on a below average opponent in the first round of sectionals, the Millers needed a spark. That came from center back Drew Cochran. Just after halftime, Drew intercepts a pass at midfield and dribbles towards the top of the 18. He takes a touch with the outside of his right boot to adjust his shooting angle. His shot bounces just before reaching the GK and takes a nice hop over his hand to tickle the twine.	The play starts with a ball into Palmer Ault at the center circle from AJ Tippner. Palmer then decides to take on nearly the entire defensive grouping of the Carroll Chargers. For most of the play it is 1 vs. 3. Ault deftly moves the defense until he is able to get a shooting angle and blasts home a shot to the far post from outside the 18.

#3 Spencer Holland vs. Lawrence Central	#14 Palmer Ault vs. Carmel
Spencer Holland was Johnny on the spot for this goal. The LC backline was careless with a pass back and Spencer pounced on it with such speed. He takes a nice touch around 1 defender to set up a 1 v 1 with the goalie. What makes the goal better is Spencer's cut around the goalie and the fact that he puts it in the back of the net while being fouled by the keeper. The GK received a yellow card for his shenanigans.	This is Ault's 2nd of 3 goals on the day against Carmel. Once again, Ault dribbles several defenders and at one time there are 4 defenders keying in on him. Regardless, Ault shoots from the top of the penalty area. His shot deflects off of one of the defenders which is what freezes the GK for the greyhounds.

#6 Drew Barnes vs. Homestead	#11 Garrett Poynter vs. Muncie Central
This goal shows just how quickly the 2020 Millers could score. The play starts with a distribution from Gabe Ingle at GK. He plays a 55 yard ball up to the front line. Drew Barnes heads it to Palmer Ault who controls. Immediately Drew Barnes takes off to make a nice curved run around a Spartan center back. Ault plays a perfectly weighted ball that sends Barnes in on goal. He slots the a shot far post past the keeper.	This play starts with nice combination play from our center midfielders of Brayden Doll and Kyle Goad. Spencer Holland also gets in on the mix. It is Goad's through ball to the left that springs Poynter in on goal and he calmly slots it home.

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#7 Andy Stansfield vs. Muncie Central	#10 Palmer Ault vs. Westfield
Andy Stansfield gets his first goal of the season (and varsity career) on this cheeky finish. It starts with COLin Todd making a nice overlapping run. He sends in a nicely driven cross. After a deflection. Stansfield is alone on the back post with a deft finish with his left foot. He was definitely rewarded for making a nice weak side run from his left back position	The play starts with a booming goal kick from keeper Gabe Ingle. After a poor clearance from the Westfield defense, Palmer Ault has a thunderous header to their back line. Once again, the Westfield defense has a poor clearing attempt. Ault then flicks it to himself. What is hard to see from the video is Ault's change of pace on his next touch that puts him past the back line. He finishes so well with his left foot.

#2 Kyle Marshall vs. Brownsburg	#15 Spencer Holland vs. Guerin (Scrimmage)
This play starts AND ends with Kyle Marshall. He makes the first pass in his defensive half of the pitch. Garrett Poytner dribbles up the left flank and then sends a through ball to Sam VanMeter. At the edge of the 18, VanMeter hits a great, weighted cross. It goes over 2 Brownsburg defenders and lands at the penalty spot. Marshall hits a great half-volley shot with pace which zips over the keeper into the back of the net. What is lost in the play is Marshall's recognition that he needs to haul to get into position for the cross. As the through ball is played to VanMeter at the 7 second mark of the clip, you can see Marshall kick it into high gear. His field awareness was rewarded on this play.	A short clip but a goal nonetheless. The Guerin defense was quite careless with their pass along the backline. An opportunistic Spencer Holland intercepted a hospital pass and was able to slot home a nice low shot to the right post.

Hart Region - Round 1

#1 Kyle Goad vs. Brownsburg	#16 Drew Barnes vs. Fishers
This goal is even more remarkable considering the circumstances and pressure. Our unbeaten season on the line in our last regular season match. Yes, we had already sewn up a conference championship, but we wanted to remain unbeaten. With the Millers losing 2-1, Palmer Ault has a throw-in deep down the left flank. Garrett Poytner controls the throw and immediately dishes it back to Ault. Ault hits a one time cross with the perfect weight just over the keeper. At this moment Kyle Goad positions himself and has a perfect flick that goes upper 90 and ties the match. This is the goal that kept us unbeaten heading into sectionals	Drew Barnes was able to convert a PK after Palmer Ault was fouled in the penalty area. This PK tied the game up at 1-1 with about 20 minutes to go in the game.

#8 Palmer Ault vs. Carmel	#9 Spencer Holland vs. Guerin
A play that started from the defensive third of the field. Kyle Goad played a magnificent through ball over the Carmel back line to a streaking Ault. The Carmel GK tried to come out and play it but Ault chipped it over him. He then ran with the ball to make sure it slipped inside the post. This was Ault's first of 3 goals on the game	A play that started with Kyle Goad and Palmer Ault connecting in the center of the pitch. Palmer then dribbled towards goal to find a nice little slip through ball to sprinting Spencer Holland on the right flank. The best part of the goal is the touch Holland has with his chip over a sliding goalkeeper.

#4 Kyle Marshall vs. Homestead	#13 Drew Barnes vs. Homestead
After some ping-ponging around with the ball in the middle of the pitch, Drew Barnes is sent in on a through ball up the left flank. After getting into the box, Barnes sent a nice cross across the 6. A streaking Kyle Marshall got a nice one-touch shot on frame and his shot went basically bar down for a great goal.	This was a man's goal. Kyle Goad sends a long ball up to striker Drew Barnes. Barnes takes a quick first touch around the defender. From there Barnes uses pure speed and strength to blow by the Spartan defender. He then slots it with his left foot underneath a diving GK to the far post.

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#5 Palmer Ault vs. Carroll	#12 Spencer Holland vs. Greenfield - Central
This was a quick-developing play. The Millers won the ball in the midfield. Kyle Goad sent a long ball over the Chargers back line. Palmer Ault was in a foot race with their center back. The defender thought they had shielded the ball well. Ault had other plans. With a sneaky good touch, Ault had a quick toe poke that sent the ball over an unsuspecting goalie.	This play started with a ball sent forward off the foot of Drew Cochran. It deflects off a G-C defender and falls to the foot of Palmer Ault. Hearing Spencer Holland calling for a through ball, Ault sends a pass blind into space knowing that Holland has the speed to race onto it. This especially works because G-C is playing such a high line that Holland has tons of space to work with. Holland freezes the goalie with a nice, hard, low shot near post

#3 Drew Barnes vs. Carmel	#14 Palmer Ault vs. Guerin (Scrimmage)
The play starts with a throw-in deep in the Carmel half. Instead of launching a throw into the box, the Millers play support back to Colin Todd. From the left flank, Todd sends a cross towards the top of the 18. What is hard to see is the fantastic touch from Kyle Goad. With a back heel, plays Drew Barnes in behind the defense. Barnes makes no doubt about the goal to open the scoring 1-0 against one of our most bitter rivals. That goal set the tone for the rest of the 5-0 drubbing of the Greyhounds.	Palmer Ault starts this play controlling the ball on the right flank in the offensive half. He dribbles towards the top of the 18 keeping the attention of 5 Guerin defenders. This allows Garrett Poytner to make a nice diagonal run across the back line. Ault sends a nice slip pass that sends Poytner in the penalty area. What is lost on the Guerin defenders is that Ault continues to make his curling run to the back post. Poytner finds him with a cross across the top of the 6 and he neatly taps it in the net as multiple defenders and the goalie try to recover.

#6 Jordan Hinds vs. Muncie Central	#11 Palmer Ault vs. Brebeuf
Kyle Marshall starts the play with a corner kick from the right flank. After a slight clearance from Muncie Central, the ball is played back to Marshall who gets a second chance on a cross. It once again deflects in the box but settles down nicely in front of Jordan Hinds. Hinds makes no doubt about the shot as he goes upper 90 near post for his first varsity goal.	Brayden Doll starts the play with a free kick from near the right corner flag. The play happens fast but Doll delivers the ball right to Palmer Ault's foot as he crashes the frame. He blasts it in for a no-doubter.

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#7 Spencer Holland vs. Avon	#10 Drew Barnes vs. Brebeuf
There is a lot to digest on this play but it all happens quickly. First, Palmer Ault dispossesses an Avon defender near the center circle. Then Kyle Goad gains possession of the ball and dribbles to break down the defense. Goad then hits a lovely pass with the outside of his right foot to diagonally to a straight run from Spencer Holland. At first it looks like Holland's first touch is poor as it pops up. Holland instead recovers and hits a great rising half volley that goes over the keeper but bar down.	From the video, the beginning of the goal is hard to see. Maybe because it is in front of the far sideline where the lighting isn't as good. OR it's because Spencer Holland is just so quick. A ball is played up the right flank. A Brebeuf defender lets it roll and tries to shield the ball as it goes out of touch. However, Holland sneaks around the shield and has a direct line in on goal. Once Holland gets into the penalty area, he slips a ball across to a trailing Drew Barnes for the easy tap in.

#2 Drew Barnes vs. HSE	#15 Palmer Ault vs. Muncie Central
The amount of teamwork on this goal is what makes it so impressive. It starts with Kyle Marshall on the ball. He lays off a pass to Colin Todd, who then makes a nice, strong pass up to a checking Drew Barnes. Even though there is no sound, Coach Dollaske was yelling, "Time, Turn, Opposite" to Barnes as he received the ball, which is exactly what Barnes does. He plays Garrett Poytner into space on the weak side as the defense is slow to recover. Poytner attacks a defender 1v1, which allows Palmer Ault to make an overlapping run to the outside. Poytner slips him a through ball. Ault then dishes a perfect low cross across the box to none other than Drew Barnes, who continued his run from the middle of the pitch, for a nice easy tap in.	The build up of this play starts in the back line with Drew Cochran. He slots a pass to Spencer Holland who takes off at breakneck speed. He takes a couple of touches and then sends a perfectly weighted through ball past 3 Muncie Central defenders and hits Palmer Ault in Stride. Ault takes 2 touches and then buries a shot low, far post past a diving keeper.

Webster Region - Round 1

#1 Brady Horn vs. Lawrence Central	#16 Spencer Holland vs. Cathedral
This play starts with a corner kick from Brayden Doll on the far side of the pitch. Lawrence Central has 2 different opportunities for a clearance. The first defender pops the ball straight up. The 2nd defender has a weak header back towards the middle of the penalty area. From just beyond the penalty spot, Brady Horn contorts his body and hits a wicked half volley with his laces. The ball screams into the upper 90. After just scoring his first varsity goal and a beauty at that, Brady Horn then screams too as he celebrates with his teammates.	With the game tied at 1-1, Spencer Holland stepped up to take a PK. Spencer knows that after already having saved a previous PK attempt from another Miller player, the goalie is eager to guess a direction as the PK is kicked. So what does Spencer do? Kick it right down the middle, much to the dismay of the Cathedral goalie.

#8 Spencer Holland vs. Westfield	#9 Palmer Ault vs. Muncie Central
Here is yet another sequence that showed how dangerous the 2020 Millers were and how quickly they could score. The play starts with a distribution from GK Gabe Ingle. The kick connects with Drew Barnes, who flicks the ball further up the pitch. Garrett Poytner deftly hits a one touch pass with his left foot to an on-running Holland. Holland takes one touch away from pressure and then buries his left footed shot.	A play that takes place on the right flank. Colin Todd, from his right back position, plays a one touch pass up the touchline to Spencer Holland. Holland looks to take it deep but cuts it back when the defender takes away his angle to the near post. He sends a left footed cross towards the near post. Palmer Ault makes a nice run to flick the header in near post past the goalie.

#4 Palmer Ault vs. Carmel	#13 Garrett Poynter vs. Franklin Central
Palmer Ault gets the goal here, but it is Spencer Holland who does much of the work. Holland wins the ball at midfield. He ends up dribbling 4 Greyhounds while slicing up the Carmel defense. Ault is able to time his run perfectly to stay onside but then sneak behind their back line. What is hard to see from the clip is that Ault's shot actually goes through the GK's legs as the keeper is diving to the ground	Due to the view from the FC press box, we aren't able to see the ball hit the twine on this goal. The play starts with a defensive header from Brayden Doll around midfield. Palmer Ault gains possession and continues to nutmeg 1 defender and beat another. He then sends a left footed pass that sends Garrett Poynter in on frame. Poynter makes no doubt as he shoots past a sprawling keeper.

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#5 Brayden Doll vs. Zionsville	#12 Drew Barnes vs. Zionsville
Free Kick from about 27 yards out for Brayden Doll. He puts a nice curler with pace on frame. Due to the spin and power, the keeper misjudges it a bit and the ball finds the back of the net. What really makes this goal is the team coordinated celebration at the end of the clip.	This play starts with Palmer Ault collecting possession in the offensive third. 3 Zionsville defenders collapse to him, which allows him to slot Drew Barnes into the penalty area. Barnes hits a low shot towards the far post. The keeper is able to make a partial save but the ball has enough momentum to cross the endline for a goal.

#3 Palmer Ault vs. Carroll	#14 Drew Barnes vs. Muncie Central
Palmer Ault dispossesses a defender right at the center circle. He quickly dribbles up field with multiple defenders tracking him. Ault releases a pass to a diagonal run made by Spencer Holland. While it is difficult to see in the clip, Holland makes a magisterial back-heel touch that sends Ault in on goal behind all the defenders. If you're not paying attention to the clip, you will miss that Holland touch. Ault does the rest with a well-placed low shot to beat the keeper. (Highlights from NBC in Fort Wayne that shows the goal too)	The play starts down the left flank with a cross in. The ball caroms off multiple players. It surreptitiously falls to Drew Barnes who was able to get behind the defense. His shot is initially saved by the keeper but the momentum of the shot takes it in the goal.

#6 Garret Poynter vs. Guerin	#11 Kyle Marshall vs. Lawrence Central
After a quick pass from Colin Todd to Palmer Ault, Ault sends a lofted cross across the pitch to just inside the 18. The Guerin GK tries to come off his line but Garrett Poynter gets to the ball first and expertly taps it in and avoids a potentially nasty collision with the goalie too.	It starts with Jake Sexton receiving a pass and turning to find support up the right flank. Sexton continues his run towards goal and receives a return pass. Sexton puts a shot on goal but it is turned away by the LC keeper. The LC keeper looks stunned with what appears to be a twisted ankle as he tries to walk it off towards the endline. The ball rebounds out to the 18 where an LC defender converges with AJ Tippner. They reach the ball at the same time, putting some wicked spin on the ball as it launches back towards the goal. Kyle Marshall slides to make contact with the spinning ball and puts a shot on frame. Initially it is saved by the GK who has returned to his net, but he doesn't have a good grip on the ball and it makes its way to the back of the net.

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#7 Cole Bramblett vs. Westfield	#10 Spencer Holland vs. Muncie Central
The play starts with Drew Barnes taking the ball deep to the endline on the right flank. He plays a nice give-n-go combination with Spencer Holland. Barnes takes the pass back and hits a 1 touch cross. The cross is immediately deflected by a Westfield defender, causing the cross to go much higher than originally intended. This freezes the goalkeeper who can't track the path of the ball from near post to far post. Which is great news for Cole Bramblett who has made a weak side run to the back post and cleverly volleys it home.	Simple play completed by 1 player. Spencer Holland received a nicely weighted pass from the back line. He turns, beats 1 defender and then sees nothing but green in front of him. When he gets near the 18, he takes a touch to change his shooting angle and blasts a nice left footed shot back against the grain to beat the GK.
#2 Palmer Ault vs. Homestead	#15 Spencer Holland vs. Guerin (Scrimmage)
The play starts with a quick restart by Kyle Goad who plays into Garrett Poytner's feet. Poytner takes 2 touches and then sends a cross field pass to Spencer Holland. This is where the magic happens. Palmer Ault calls for a through ball to break the back line of 3 defenders. With his left foot, Holland hits a 1 touch pass with precision, weight and accuracy which puts Ault in on goal. Honestly, this is one of the nicest passes in NHS history! (**Coach Dollaske's opinion. You are welcome to disagree) Ault does the rest with a nice low finish past a diving goalie.	The play starts with Kyle Goad being fouled at the center circle. Goad takes a quick peak and decides the quick restart is on with Spencer Holland. Goad plays a lofted ball over the back line for Holland to run on to. The Guerin goalie misjudges the pace of the pass and is unable to corral the ball. Instead, Holland slots it home.

Doering Region - Round 1

#1 Drew Barnes vs Westfield	#16 Palmer Ault vs. Muncie Central
It is a shame that A) our camera crew had to be at the corner of the stands instead of at midfield due to needing an electrical outlet and B) the lighting is not the greatest... because this goal was straight out of the Harlem Globetrotters playbook. The play starts with Palmer Ault shielding the ball from a defender near the endline and edge of the penalty area. He tries to cross but it is blocked. Ault chases the ball which causes a poor clearance by a Westfield defender. The ball rolls to Kyle Goad. Goad sees Ault continuing his run so he uses a back heel pass. At the same time Spencer Holland also goes to receive the pass, drawing a defender with him. Holland dummies the pass and allows Ault to take it towards the top of the D. Holland continues his looping run and is rewarded with a pass back from Ault. As Holland receives the ball a defender closes so Holland cuts the ball back. Holland sees a streaking Drew Barnes and he hits a nice toe-poke pass into Barnes' path. The goalie thought the pass was going far post so he is out of position as Barnes is able to tap it in near post.	This play starts with a nice series of passes from the back line to the left flank then into Palmer Ault in the center of the field. Ault then plays a 1-2 combo with striker Drew Barnes. Ault takes a touch to elude a defender and hits a rocket from the top of the penalty area to the near post.

#8 Spencer Holland vs. Cathedral	#9 Spencer Holland vs. Lawrence Central
This was a two man game. Well, actually a 1 man game with a simple tap in for the 2nd man. Palmer Ault receives the ball on his own half of the pitch. He then uses pure speed to beat the entire Cathedral back line down the left flank. Spencer Holland makes the run with him and is staying on the back post outside of the weak side defender. As the cross is sent across the top of the goal area, Holland cuts inside of the defender for the nice left footed tap in.	After swinging the ball around the back like with Drew Cochran, Brady Horn, and Colin Todd, the ball moves into the midfield with Garrett Poynter. He receives and then looks opposite for an over the top switch. The timing of the play is perfect as the ball is played right as Spencer Holland is even with a back line that is trying to play an offside trap (poorly!). By the time Holland receives the ball he is 10 yards clear of the closest defender. He takes the ball wide and then slots the ball low far post.

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#4 Kyle Goad vs. Avon	#13 Palmer Ault vs. Zionsville
To start this play, the Miller center mids dispossess Avon at the center circle. Garrett Poytner slots the ball out to Cameron Jarrett who then plays a ball in to Drew Barnes. Barnes takes the ball to the endline. He draws the defense in and then slots a pass back to a trailing Kyle Goad who finishes far post.	The play starts with Drew Cochran bringing the ball up the pitch from his center back position. He plays the ball wide to his right wing back Colin Todd. Todd attempts a pass to Palmer Ault playing the CAM position but the pass is just off target. Luckily a Zionsville defender takes a poor touch and Ault regains possession. He dribbles towards goal and then slots a ball to a diagonal run made by Spencer Holland. Holland tries to cross back to Ault but it is stopped by a defender. This same defender falls down, allowing Ault to pounce and bury it in the back of the net.

#5 Sam VanMeter vs. Brebeuf	#12 Drew Barnes vs. Avon
The play starts with a thrown in on the far right flank. Drew Barnes does an excellent job of shielding his defender and lets the ball run through him. After putting 2 moves on a defender, Barnes is able to get off a cross. The cross is perfectly weighted to avoid 2 Brebeuf defenders and land at the feet of Sam VanMeter. VanMeter coolly hits a quick half volley before the goalie can slide from near to back post.	Colin Todd starts the play with a throw in from his left back position. He finds Palmer Ault who draws the attention of 3 defenders. He slots a ball across the top of the 18 to Spencer Holland, who deftly hits a one touch pass to Drew Barnes to put him in on goal. Barnes takes a quick touch to control and then unleashes a shot low to the far post.

#3 Garrett Poynter vs. Brebeuf	#14 Palmer Ault vs. Lawrence Central
The play begins with Luke Watness taking a few touches up the pitch from his right back position. He then plays a nice, lofted ball bypassing the midfield and finds striker Drew Barnes in stride. The Brebeuf goalie comes way off his line and misjudges the pass. Barnes takes a touch wide to get around him, but other defenders are tracking back to help support. Barnes doesn't panic as he takes one touch and picks up his head to find his target: Garrett Poytner who has drifted to the back post. Barnes hits a drive cross that Poytner effortlessly half volleys in the back of the net.	Cole Bramblett starts the play by intercepting a pass on the right flank. He plays the ball up the pitch to Jake Sexton. Sexton takes one touch and then dishes to a streaking Palmer Ault at midfield. Ault's first touch to elude a defender is simply divine. Ault then races up the pitch, beating 2 defenders along the way. Finally, when he gets near the 18 he cracks a shot low to the far post. The keeper has no chance.

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#6 Palmer Ault vs. Westfield	#11 Spencer Holland vs. Franklin Central
Drew Barnes sends a nicely weighted pass out wide to Spencer Holland on the right flank. Barnes continues his past Holland which distracts the defense. At the same time Holland does a nice step over move and cuts inside. As the defense collapses, Holland does his patented toe poke slip pass on to a streaking Palmer Ault breaking through the back line. Ault takes one touch and then buries it far post.	The clip is limited by the press box at FC. Gabe Ingle hits a long ball distribution from his GK position. After some quick touches by Drew Barnes and Garrett Poytner, the ball comes to Palmer Ault. He sees an easily threaded through ball to Holland on the right side. Holland lets the ball run so he can hit the shot first touch with his right foot. Boom. Goal.

#7 Palmer Ault vs. Franklin Central	#10 Drew Barnes vs. Lawrence Central
This clip is short. Spencer Holland dribbles up the center of the pitch. No defenders close him down. He is able to take space until he sees Palmer Ault making a nice vertical run. Holland slots the pass and Ault is able to finish as the goalie comes out to cut down the angle.	Drew Cochran plays a lovely long ball over the top from his center back position. The LC goalie tries to come off his line and get the ball first but Drew Barnes has other plans. With the goalie out of position, Barnes just has one defender trailing him that he must fend off. Alertly, Barnes throws on the brakes and causes the defender to slip. This allows Barnes an easy tap in for goal.

Alertly, Barnes instead of trying to control uses a back heel to chip the ball over an HSE defender and on to Ault. Ault heads it to himself. The HSE defender recovered and tried to clear the ball, The only problem. Ault's face was in the way. The clearance went off of Ault's face and directly into the goal, much to the surprise of the HSE goalkeeper.
