INSTRUCTIONS

LEARN AND EXPLORE

STEP 1

- Students will join the Adobe Spark Classroom
- Adobe Spark Professional Learning Kit
- What is Adobe Spark?
- Teach Spark on Chromebooks Video

STEP 2

- Students will reflect on their new remote learning environment and brainstorm on successes during this time as their proud moment.
- Students will create an Adobe Spark Page to share their story. This portfolio page can be a combination of photos, videos, or write-ups

STEP 3

 Students will write about their learning, and gather images that represent the event.

CREATE

STEP 1

- Storyboard the event that you are sharing. Collect the images and design a post or add directly to the Spark Page.
- Option to create the story and narrate in Adobe Spark Video and add to your page.

STEP 2

- Include Profile Picture and Name
- Take a look online portfolio examples for some inspiration

STEP 3

- Your work progress will be viewed in Adobe Spark Classroom
- Your Published page will be added to your Portfolio and the link will be collected and shared through a form.


