NARRATIVE REPORT ON D2 YOUTH ORIENTATION SEMINAR 2025

I. INTRODUCTION

In support of the government's commitment to expanding access to quality education and promoting equal opportunities for learners pursuant to **Republic Act No. 10931** (Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education Act) and aligned with the goals of learner empowerment under **Republic Act No. 10533** (Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013), an **Orientation on the Iskolar ni Gob Program** was conducted on **October 24, 2025**, at **Pantay Integrated High School**.

The activity was attended by selected **Grade 12 students** who were identified as eligible applicants for the scholarship program. The orientation aimed to provide guidance to qualified learners regarding the application procedures, eligibility requirements, documentary submissions, and screening process. It also sought to ensure that students clearly understood the steps necessary to successfully complete the scholarship application and examination requirements.

II. OBJECTIVES

To identify Grade 12 students who are eligible for the Iskolar ni Gob Program.
To orient students on the proper way of filling out the scholarship application forms.
To explain the requirements needed to qualify for the scholarship.
To guide students on how to secure a test permit and take the scholarship examination.

III. SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

During the orientation, Grade 12 students who met the academic requirement—having no subject grade below 85—were identified as eligible applicants for the Iskolar ni Gob Program. This helped ensure that only qualified students were guided through the process.

The orientation was led by Ma'am Maricel Baltazar, Officer-in-Charge (OIC) of Pantay Integrated High School. She clearly explained the step-by-step process of properly filling out the application forms to avoid errors that may affect the students' chances of qualifying.

Ma'am Baltazar also discussed the complete list of requirements needed for the scholarship application. She emphasized the importance of submitting correct and complete documents to be able to receive a test permit. The students were further informed that passing the examination is required to determine whether they will officially qualify as scholars.



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The activity provided students with a clear understanding of the scholarship process and helped prepare them for the next steps, including document submission and examination.

The Iskolar ni Gob Orientation was successful in informing and guiding eligible Grade 12 students. Through proper orientation and clear instructions, the students were given a better opportunity to prepare and apply for the scholarship. The activity played an important role in supporting students who aim to continue their studies through educational assistance programs.
