 This work occurs from within the walls of the house. A danced duet, a fractured subject but one porous being, moves through the depths of interiority in ways that reside in and exceed the borders of the living room. Informed by Gaston Bachelard's *Poetics of Space*, this work challenges a stable, linear narrative yet is rooted in the immediacy, risk, and vitality of the dancing body. Dancers engage vigorously with the varied terrain of the house, from descending into the darkness of the cellar to climbing into the dreams of the tower, and stepping out into the ethereality of garden.

[Devin Arne](#) composes an original sound score sourced from the rehearsal room and sounds of the home; this work is an organism that explores how the house—as psychic and choreographic architecture—can be embodied, sonically layered, destabilized, and multiplied across bodies, site, sounds, and time.
