

# Romeo and Juliet Prologue Project

Create a media presentation in which you perform the prologue for *Romeo and Juliet*. You may work alone, or you may work with a partner or two. If you work with a friend, each voice must be part of the presentation. That is, you can't make just one person perform all the lines, even though that person's voice is way more beautiful than yours. This is an oral communications project, so each participant should demonstrate his or her skills.

You may choose any media tool you like, but choose something that you will be able to upload to YouTube so that you can turn your work in by posting a YouTube link into a Schoology discussion. Possible tools or apps include: PowTunes, Adobe Spark, Educreations, or iMovie. If you find others that you think might work, just ask.

<b>Standards and Points Possible</b>	<b>Your Score -- /50</b>
Presentation should be 1 ½ - 5 minutes long. You will lose points if it is shorter or longer than this.	(Penalty points only.)
<b>Articulation (10)</b> --Each word is carefully articulated, pronounced correctly, and performed without hesitation or stumbling.	
<b>Volume and Rate (10)</b> -- The lines are easy to hear and spoken at an appropriate rate.	
<b>Understanding (10)</b> -- The lines are performed in a way that demonstrates the speaker's understanding and helps the listener to make sense of the meaning.	
<b>Use of Media Tool (10)</b> -- The media tool chosen works well for this project and is used correctly and creatively.	
<b>Creativity/Entertainment Value (10)</b> -- The presentation is enjoyable to watch and demonstrates that the creators put thought and effort into making it fun for others to watch.	

**Note: I will add five bonus points to projects that get more than 100 YouTube views. I will add ten points to those that get more than 200 views.**
