

Landscape Architecture and Design P (K7669)

Recommended Prerequisite: None

This course examines the relationship between people and their environment. Students will develop an awareness of the interactive relationship between humans and how they shape their setting. They will also gain an appreciation for the historical and cultural traditions that are reflected in landscape architectural designs. Students will be exposed to various spatial planning and design theories and practices, as well as examples of cases of community design and landscape architecture projects. The course takes a project based learning approach, and there is a focus on applying landscape architecture theories and principles through making physical models.
