School Update (Allison Stoffman, Jill Martin)

- Terry Fox Run raised \$2000
- Open House and Bookfair had a great turn out of parents and students who attended
- Fall fire drill procedures have begun, 3x fire drills in total with an impressive time of 2 mins for everyone to exit the building
- Fall lockdown drill coming up, typically happens during a police officer visit
- Congratulations to our junior and intermediate cross country runners who placed as top 10 finishers at the cross country meet
- Our foot and bus patrollers are fully trained and actively working to keep everyone safe
- Progress reports are expected by mid November with parent/teacher interviews to follow
- Grade 4 field trip to the movie theatre to see The Wild Robot movie
- The multi-year plan is working to identify and monitor students who are not performing to standard and continued focus on attendance monitoring
- EQAO results were above the provincial average level
- Clubs, sports and teams have started and will continue to pop up, stay tuned
- Mr. Duncan and Mrs. McDermott will be holding auditions for the musical: The Storm
- Remembrance Day assembly will be held on November 11th – a letter will be sent home to welcome and encourage students to bring in or share a photo of a service person, to be added to our Remembrance Day slideshow
- Field trips to the River Run Centre will be starting soon
- Picture Retake day is October 30th
- Discussion about changing bell times slightly as we are the only/last school in our district to run 45 minute breaks rather than 40 minutes. The current bell schedule allows for a 20 minute nutrition break and 25 minute recess. The idea is to schedule 20 minutes for both, eliminating the last 5 minutes. Updates to come.
- There have been no updates shared with admin regarding construction for expansion (adding 6 classes and second gym).
- FDK teachers requested \$1000 to be used towards toys/equipment for FDK playground rather than track line painting. The funds have since been approved and reallocated.
- Admin plan to continue weekly school information email for parents
- Admin are working to keep website calendar up to date
