Регламент підсумкового модульного контролю модулю № 7 «Дитяча хірургія» для студентів 5 курсу при дистанційній формі навчання.

The final module control is carried out upon completion of the study program of module 7: "Pediatric Surgery" and is conducted at the last lesson of the module. For the implementation of the final modular control it is possible to use the system "Nero", messengers Facebook, Skype, Viber, Telegram, programs for video conferencing (such as Google Classroom, Zoom), e-mail and more

Students who have completed all the tasks provided by the program for the module "Pediatric Surgery" and do not have academic debt, more than 25% of the curriculum of the cycle are admitted to the final module control.

The maximum number of points that a student can score when completing the final module control is 120 points. The final module control is credited to the student if he scored at least 60 points.

Grade for the module (total): Maximum PMK - 200 points (table 1).

Table 1. Conversion of points from the discipline to the traditional scale:

The final modular control consists of three main parts:

- 1. Test control
- 2. Practical tasks;
- 3. Solving clinical situations.

The first part of the final modular control.

Test control.

The tasks of the test control are to control the knowledge and skills of students is to prepare for the licensed integrated exam "Step-2". Test control includes 50 test tasks, each of which is a specific clinical situation, questions to it and 5 answer options, from which you must choose 1 correct one. Test questions control the knowledge of etiology, pathogenesis, clinical manifestations, treatment, prevention and prognosis of diseases and reflect the curriculum in pediatric surgery in the 5th year. Testing duration - 60 minutes.

Evaluation of the first part of the final module control

The maximum score of this stage is 50 points, which is 1 point for the correct answer to 1 test, incorrectly solved test - 0 points.

Students who scored less than 30 points (60%) receive a grade of "unsatisfactory" (2) for PMK and are not allowed to the next stages of the exam.

The second part of the final modular control

Practical skills, writing a medical history and working directly with patients Evaluated:

Monitoring the implementation of practical skills. The maximum number of points for the practical task is 7 points. The maximum number of points for 5 practical skills is 35 points.

The third part of the final modular control

Solving clinical situations.

The student answers the task of the examination ticket, which contains:

- 1) The maximum score for a clinical task 7 points.
- 2) Situational task
- 3) Functional research, analysis.

The total score for the final module control is defined as the sum of the scores of all components of the final module control (table 2).
