Quadra Alpha:

- ILE: SO7, SO5, SP7.
- LII: SO6, SX5.
- ESE: SX2, SP2, SO9.
- SEI: SP2.

Quadra Gamma:

- SEE: SX8, SX4, SO2, SO8.
- ESI: SP4, SP1, SO9, SX4.
- LIE: SO7.
- ILI: SP5, SO5.

Quadra Delta:

- LSE: SP3, SX1, SP1 (?).
- SLI: SP9, SP5.
- IEE: SO3, SX7, SP7.
- EII: SP6, SX3, SX9, SO4.

Quadra Beta:

- EIE: SO2 (?), SO1.
- IEI: SX5 (?), SX7.
- SLE: SP8, SX6 (?).
- LSI: SX6, SX1, SO6, SP1
