Fort Atkinson Vocational/Technical Scholarship

1. Available to study at any vocational/technical college which is accredited in a program of one or two years.
2. Available to Fort Atkinson High School seniors and anyone who has received a high school diploma and lives or works in Jefferson County.
3. Applications are available in the FAHS Pupil Services Office, Fort Atkinson Madison College, and online at www.fortvotech.com.
4. Multiple scholarships are awarded for varying amounts.
5. Applications are due to the High School Pupil Services Office or Fort Atkinson Madison College April 1, 2024.

JEFFERSON COUNTY AGRI-BUSINESS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP

1. Must be a resident of Jefferson County or attend a Jefferson County school.
2. Applicants must be a high school senior planning to attend a 2- or 4-year college majoring in an agricultural or ag-related program or the UW Farm & Industry Short Course Program.
OR
Applicant may be a college student currently enrolled in a 2- or 4-year agricultural program or the UW Farm & Industry Short Course Program and planning to continue enrollment in the agricultural program the following year.
3. Recipient selection will include the following criteria: Educational and career plans in an agricultural field, academic record, FFA activities, other high school activities, 4-H activities, community activities, involvement in agribusiness functions, employment
4. Financial Need will be considered.
5. Application available on Pupil Services website.
6. **Application due January 31.**
7. Letters of Recommendation required.
8. **Recipients are asked to volunteer a minimum of 5 hours at the Jefferson County Fair Agribusiness Food Tent in July or at the Farm Technology Days Agribusiness Food Booth in July.**
