- The energy gained from most quest rewards will add to your Over max level if you complete them while at maximum energy.
- Sets are Collections and never need found just exchanged if you already have them.

## A Day Off



Now that all the work is done and tomorrow is no longer a concern, there's time left for some art.



"Decorating your home is an art. Buy 6 flowerbeds." **It will count to buy less expensive flowers than those shown!**

The 'Red roses' for 10,000 gold coins count as well as the 'Red tulips' for 7,000 coins. Market > Decorations > Flowerbeds. Buy 6 'Red Tulips' to save money. **(ALWAYS buy 1 and check to see if it registered on quest before buying more)** Skip for 10 



Enclose your entire territory with fences to prevent wild ..."  
Regular fences don't actually keep animals corralled.

**Purchase and place 10 fences anywhere.** Skip for 10 



"Invite people to your home..." **Invite = hire. You can speed this quest along if you wish by hiring into the tent for the**

shortest time and firing, rehire/fire to complete the 20 hires.

Skip for 5 

The neighbors appreciated my efforts and brought me all kinds of gifts: something for the farm, as well as something for the soul.


Rewards: 10 Worms , 10 Energy , 10,000 Coins

### Day Dreaming (rewards updated January 6, 2020)

When the candle died out, the house fell into darkness and sleep.




Send any of the 'Free' Daily Gifts to 30 people with or WITHOUT a message written. Skip for 10 



Make 3 Matches in the Barn. 2 Goose egg baskets and 20 Wool are needed to create a match in the barn for a total of 6 Goose egg baskets and 60 Wool to get credit for this quest. Skip for 25 




The Triple street lamp is located in Market > Decorations > Decorations. Either Triple street lamp will count. Place it where ever you wish.

Skip for 3 


There was a soft knock on the door. I saw a traveler standing in the doorstep shivering with cold and hunger. He needed to take a rest and dry his clothes.

Rewards: 2500 Experience , 10 Coffee , 5  Cable




Collect 40 dry twigs. Dry twigs are from bushes. Skip for 10 



Raise 6 geese.. Skip for 10 



Exchange 1 stone sets. Skip for 2 

The traveler warmed up and cheered up. He said that he had come here to find the Tigroid nugget, whose legend had been shared with him by an Indian from Dawson.

Rewards: 40,000 Coins , 10 Nails , 30 Energy 



### [The Legend. Part 1](#) (updated January 6, 2020)

**I adore legends and mysteries.**



Sell 10 coffee beans. Coffee beans do NOT have to be harvested just sold from Storage. Ask a friend to send some if you don't have enough. Skip for 5



Ask a friend for 10 water or collect 10 water in free gifts. Skip for 5



Sell 2 matches from Storage. Skip for 5

**Long, long ago there was a brave hunter from a northern tribe who fell in love with a chieftain's daughter, The chieftain ordered the hunter to bring him the fell (skin) of a white tiger: only then would he give him permission to wed his daughter.**

Rewards: 1500 Experience , 2 Oak Leaf , 5 Bed

**The story turned out to be a long one. It was sunrise already.**



Exchange 2 Inuit Sets. Skip for 3



Exchange 2 Viking Sets. Skip for 3



Sell 5 - 100 oz nuggets from Storage > Gold Skip for 5

**The hunter had been roaming the mountains in search of a white tiger for two long years. And when he finally brought its fell (skin) to the tribe's chieftain, he got to know about a terrible misfortune.**


Rewards: 2 Aspen Leaves , 20 Golden Shovels , 30 Instant Plant Fertilizer

### [The Legend. Part 3](#) (updated January 6, 2020)

**The traveler stopped speaking and was silently musing on the fire flames.**




Collect 15 milk from your cows. Skip for 8 






Collect 15 wool from your sheep. Skip for 5 



Collect 15 nests from your home station or your neighbor's land while visiting. (You must hire the neighbor to collect their nests.) 25 Nests are laid randomly throughout the player's home station. Many times they are hidden behind rocks and trees. Mouse over the rocks, trees, or buildings to reveal the nests. **(Best Emerald item in game is a cat that does this for you)**

Skip for 10 

**The chieftain broke his promise; he had decided to marry his daughter off to another, more affluent suitor. The daughter refused to honor her father's choice. She threw herself in the cold water of a mountain river and instantly turned into a most beautiful white gold nugget the world had ever seen.**


Rewards: 2 Camomile  , 30 Energy  , 10 Worms

#### [The Legend. Part 4](#) (updated January 6, 2020)

**This sad legend had awakened ever person in the house, and now everybody was eagerly awaiting the ending of the traveler's story.**



Make 20 Firewood in the Barn. (Any recipe will work.) Skip for 5 



Make 50 fire. Fire is created in the Barn. (Fire from cottage also works) Remember.. It TAKES FIRE to MAKE FIRE. You will not see your total fire go up by the number stated in the recipe. Skip for 15 

**The hunter felt a grave and profound sorrow. He sat on the bank of that mountain river, wrapped in the fell (skin) of the tiger he had killed, and gazed through the clear water of the river at the pure gold nugget resting in peace at the river bottom.**


Rewards: 10 Boards  , 1,500 Experience

#### [The End of the Legend](#) (updated January 6, 2020)

**The sun is up. It's time to get dressed and get down to work.**



Click on your Character to change clothes (Also note this is where you can change you character name) Skip for 1 





Make 4 bird feed in the barn with rye and beans. Skip for 6

The hunter sat there all through the winter, never taking his eyes off the nugget. When spring arrived, the turbulent waters carried the nugget far down the stream. The hunter turned into a white tiger and followed the nugget.

Rewards: 5 Maple leaves , 5 Window

### Epilogue (updated January 6, 2020)



The traveler stood up, put the clothes that had been drying by the fire on, and looked at everybody around.



Exchange 1 Autumn sets. Skip for 2



Make 5 cables in barn. Skip for 15

Since then, there have been many hunters trying to find the white tiger and take the nugget away from him. But the white tiger, being a skilled hunter himself, has managed to trick all those who tried to catch him.

Rewards: 30 Energy , 3 Emeralds

### Tigroid nugget (updated January 6, 2020)



Start searching for white nuggets. The one who will find the very Tigroid Nugget from the legend will be rewarded with great luck.



Send 10 Free Gifts. Skip for 5



10 White gold nuggets may be found in friends' Gold Veins, Regular Pigs statues, Tribal Chicken statues, Tribal Goose statues, medium gold bearing stones (Combo chop pyrite away from home), or large gold bearing clods (50 energy to add to sled) (Wind Song has Chests +50 energy to lift. Bring those home and unload them. You will get the white gold nuggets needed.)

The legend of the Tigroid Nugget quickly spread to the nearby settlements. Everybody became obsessed with finding the nugget of pure white gold.

Rewards: 5 Emeralds , 20 Blueberries
