Explainable is committed to protecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we handle information when you use our Chrome extension, Explainable.

1. Information We Collect

Explainable does not collect any personal data from users. The extension operates entirely within your browser and does not store or transmit personal information such as your name, email, or browsing history.

2. How We Use Your Information

Explainable only extracts the text you highlight in your browser tab to provide an explanation via the GROQ API. This process does not involve the collection or storage of any personal data. The highlighted text is temporarily used solely to generate a response and is not retained by us.

3. Sharing Your Information

We do not share any user information with third parties. The highlighted text is sent directly to the GROQ API for processing and response, and no data is stored or shared beyond this functionality.

4. Security

While Explainable does not collect personal data, we are committed to ensuring that the data you choose to highlight is securely transmitted to the GROQ API. We use secure connections to protect your data during this process.

5. Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. Any changes will be posted on our extension's page in the Chrome Web Store, and we encourage you to review this policy periodically.
