Our Student-Led Conferences date is May 23rd!

The primary purpose of the conference is to provide some <u>REFLECTION</u> on the past year and some <u>PLANNING</u> for the future. Students have had the opportunity to prepare for their Student-Led Conference through their ongoing work with their classroom experiences, their Personalized Learning Plans (PLPs), and by using the grade-level Frameworks from our <u>PLP Critical Elements</u>. We encourage all Student-Led Conference conversations to move in a natural direction for each student, providing meaningful opportunities for reflection and thoughtful planning.

Our Central Vermont Career Center (CVCC) students will also have the opportunity to share their program/learning experiences during the Student-Led Conference day.

All students are expected to schedule a time with their respective TA for their Student Led-Conference on May 23rd. Your student and their TA will confirm the time with you individually. Lunch deli bar will be served from 11:30am to 12:30pm.

A couple of additional notes:

- 1. Are conferences connected to student privileges? Yes, successful completion of the student led conference ensures students will be eligible for student privileges at the start of the following school year.
- 2. What if parents/guardians cannot attend? We understand that you may not be available. We hope you can make the conference, but if not, we can connect via email or schedule another time. Students should schedule the conferences and attend either way.
